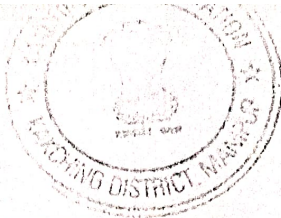

I have the honour to report that today i.e. 06/02/2026 at about 11:00 a.m, received a reliable information from my own source that one Md. Amar @Cameroon (25) yrs. s/o. Md. Khamba of Sora Ching Wangma is selling illegal contraband items at his residence. The said information was reduced in writing and was placed before the Superintendent of Police/Thoubal, Manipur. I obtained authorisation to search the premises of Md. Amar @Cameroon (25) yrs. s/o. Md. Khamba of Sora Ching Wangma from SP/Thoubal, Manipur. Without further delay a joint team of Commando Unit Thoubal led by Shri Y. Sunanta, MPS, Dy. SP (HQ), Thoubal and Inspector K. Nitranjan Singh, OC/CDO Unit Thoubal assisted by Hav. Paraj Khuman and Hav. Suresh Singh under the supervision of Smt. Divya Rajput, IPS, Addl. SP(LO) Thoubal and under the overall supervision of Shri. Manoj Prabhakar M, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Thoubal District including the source man was constituted to execute the secret report and rushed immediately towards the house of Md. Amar @Cameroon (25) yrs. s/o. Md. Khamba of Sora Ching Wangma with the acknowledgement from The District Police, Kakching.

At around 1:30 p.m., on reaching Sora Ching Wangma, the source man pointed out the house where Md. Amar @Cameroon (25) yrs. s/o. Md. Khamba of Sora Ching Wangma stayed. Afterwards, my police team approached the house and cordoned and requested the locality to witness the search procedure drill. But no one came forward to stand as witnesses. I requested Shri Y. Sunanta, MPS, Dy.SP (HQ), Thoubal and two Police Personnel of my team to stand as a witnesses and they agreed to witness the same.

A thorough verification was conducted upon the persons inside the house in presence of the witnesses. In that one individual who identified himself as Md. Amar @Cameroon (25) yrs. s/o. Md. Khamba of Sora Ching Wangma was detained and asked whereabouts of the contraband drugs. He disclosed that contraband items was kept concealed at the roof of Toilet in the front of his house.

Then, raided the homestead land of Md. Amar @Cameroon (25) yrs. s/o. Md. Khamba of Sora Ching Wangma in presence of witnesses. From the instance of Md. Amar @Cameroon (25) yrs. our police team found one black polythene packet, inside the black polythene packet found one transparent polythene packet containing i) 3 (three) nos. of BERRYCOF Cough Syrup of 100 ml each, ii) 2(two) nos. of soap cases suspected to be containing Heroin Brown Sugar,(Blue and Grey in colour) iii) 8(eight) nos. of plastic vials containing suspected to be Heroin Brown Sugar iv) 170 nos. of suspected WY Tablets contained in a blue plastic polythene v) Rs. 36,200/- (Rupees Thirty Six Thousand and Two hundred) of suspected to be fake Indian currency notes (200 x 181= Rs. 36200/-).

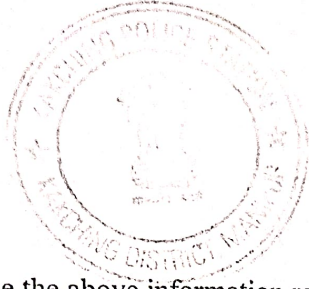
It may be mentioned that all the necessary formalities under BNSS i.e. preparation of seizure memo and arrest memo by taking videography could not be done at the spot as an information was received from intelligence sources that some organised public mob may be initiated to forcefully flee the arrested accused person and immediately some individuals of the locality including the family members numbering about 25/30 persons gathered at the spot and started pulling Amar's hand to evade arrest. The situation became worst and taking the advantage of the situation, Amar fled away from the spot. After that, all the recovered items were brought at Kakching -PS and the documentation works were prepared.

- (1) On weighing the two soap cases(Blue and grey) suspected to be containing Heroin Brown Sugar by using weighing machine and found 35 grams in total excluding the weight of two soap cases.
- (2) On weighing 8 (eight) vials suspected to be containing Heroin Brown Sugar and found 14 grams including the weight of 8 (eight) vials
- (3) On weighing the 170 nos. of suspected WY tablet and found 20 grams including the weight of blue plastic polythene.
- (4) 3 (three) nos. of BERRYCOF Cough Syrup of 100 ml each,
- (5) Rs. 36,200/- (Rupees Thirty Six Thousand and two hundred) suspected to be fake Indian currency notes (200 x 181=36,200) and
- (6) One black polythene.

All the above recovered items were seized at 04:43 pm and videography also done in presence of the Shri Y. Sunanta, MPS, Dy.SP (HQ),Thoubal.

The seized exhibits and seizure memo are handed over to you for taking further necessary legal action.
