Respected Sir/Madam

I Shri Ngamkholen Haokip aged about 45 years S/o Jamthang Haokip resident of Wakan Village Sadar Hills East Sub Division Kangpokpi District Manipur respectfully submit this complaint and request registration of a First Information Report (FIR) and a thoroughly investigation into the following facts:

1. Details of the incident : On 5th May 2023, at about 7:00pm my house located at Wakan Village Sadar Hills East Sub Division Kangpokpi District Manipur. Was attacked by a group of unknown Meetei persons armed with guns, knives and stick. The attackers chanted slogans including Hao hatlo, Kuki hatlo (meaning Kill the tribals kill the Kuki) They forcibly entered my residential hone/house i.e semi pucca building situated at wakan Village, Sadar Hills East Sub Division Kangpokpi District Manipur set fire to the premises, looted and destroyed my household belonging, furnitures, electronics, and important documents. From wjhence I was compelled for the sake of my life and safety, abandon and took shelter at Kangpokpi and later from the month of Aproil, 2023 I was from since then shelter at Changlei veng, near Molnom Village, Churachanpur, Manipur.

Nature of offence & consequences : The offences committed include arson, destruction of property, looting/theft, intimidation and ethnic violence targeted at the tribal/Kuki community.

The attack has caused :

My house being burnt and rendered uninhabitable.

Loss/destruction/looting of furnitures, , electronics, and documents, other belongings.

Displacement of my family, mental trauma, fear of further violence, and disruption of life.

Because of post- traumatic stress and fear, I was for a considerable time unaware of the process to file an FIR or approach the authorities.

4. Delay in lodging complaint- explanation & request for condonation :

I wish to respectfully state that this complaint and request for FIR registration is being made after a delay.

The reason for delay are as follows:

The shock and trauma of the house being attacked, but and the property destroyed.

The displacement from our home, safety uncertainty and the stress of fleeing under armed escort.

Lack of awareness of the proper procedure to file an FIR, and fear of reprisals or further ethnic violence.

The delay was not intentional or designed to obstruct justice, it was a consequence of grave circumstances beyond my control.

In view of the above, I humbly request that the delayed in lodging this complaint/FIR be condoned in view of the serious nature of the offence, the communal/ethnic violence dimension the displacement of the victim , and the extrordinary trauma suffered. The law allows for registration of FIR even after some delay particularly where the offence is serious and affects fundamentals rights of citizens.

5. Prayer/Relief(s) sought : In views of the foregoing, I respectfully pray that you will kindly :

a) Register a First Information Report (FIR) under the appropriate section of the Indian Penal code/BNS 2023 (for offences such as arson, destruction of proiperty, theft/looting criminal intimidation, rioting communal violence) and any other relevent law.

- b) Launch a prompt and diligent investigation : identify, arrest and prosecute the perpetrators : collect and preserve evidence (photographs of damage, witness and statement, forensic fire – scene analysis statements from my family and myself) keep me update on p[rogress.
- c) Recognise the ethnic/community violence dimension and ensure appropriate safeguards for our safety and property while the investigation proceeds.
- d) Provide mw with a copy of FIR or an official acknowledgement/diary number for my records.
- e) Consider referral to any State or central relief/compensation scheme applicable to victims of communal/ethnic violence given the destruction displacement and trauma suffered by me and my family.
- f) Condonation of the delay in filing this complaint/FIR in view of the serious circumstances described above and ensure that the delay does not result in prejudice to my rights.



Nature of offence & consequences: The offences committed include arson, destruction of property, looting/theft, intimidation, and ethnic violence targeted at the tribal/Kuki community. The attack has caused:

- My house being burnt and rendered uninhabitable.
- Loss/destruction/looting of furniture, electronics, documents, other belongings.
