I have the honour to report that today i.e. 19/02/2026, on receiving a reliable information, combined teams of CDO Unit KCG along with two Lady commando, one columns of 43 AR & HQ 28<sup>th</sup> sector and a team of Kakching PS led by SI A. Krishna Sharma, under the command of Subedar S. Birla Singh, OC/CDO Unit Kakching and under the supervision of Shri Amarjit Singh lamabam, MPS, Addl. SP( Ops), Kakching and overall supervision of Smt. Priyadarshini Laishram, IPS, Superintendent of Police kakching, conducted Joint search operation at Keirak Awang loukol Chingol area from 05.05 am to 06.30 am. During the joint search operation, the area was cordoned off and search was conducted at the suspected area of Keirak Awang loukol Chingol areas. On searching at a secluded area near bushes, the following items suspected to be kept concealed by unknown armed miscreants were found in 1 (one) plastic Rice bag (white in colour) wrapped with yellowish plastic bag. While opening the said yellowish plastic bag found the following items.

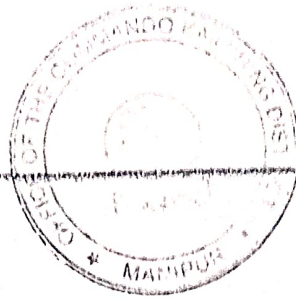
