Respected Sir,

I, Shri Mutum Tombi Singh aged about 60 years, son of Late Mutum Biramangol Singh of Tronglaobi Makha Leikai, do hereby most respectfully submit this application explaining the delay in filing the first Information Report in connection with the incident that occurred on 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2023 during the outbreak of ethnic violence in the state of Manipur.

That, on 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2023, due to large-scale violence, arson, and attacks between Kuki and Meitei communities, my residential house and properties situated at next to Kuki Village, Monghat were attacked and looted by unknown Kuki miscreants. As a result, my family suffered immense loss of property, livelihood and security.

That, owing to the sudden eruption of violence, I along with my family members, (my son, who just completed graduation and my daughter, who is going to appear board exam in 2026) was compelled to flee from our dwelling house to save our lives, leaving behind all our belongings, documents and valuables. We thereafter took shelter at Moirang College Relief Camp, Moirang, P.O./P.S. :- Moirang, Bishnupur, Manipur, where we have been residing since 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2023.

That, during the period, my family has been undergoing severe mental trauma, fear and instability. Further, I was struggling with depression and used to have social phobia which made it extremely difficult to approach the police authorities immediately.

That, my son became the only sole bread earner and my minor daughter was kept in at KGBB School, Moirang Patlou for her further study as my condition was stable.

That, from a reliable source, I came to know that my house of Kuchcha construction was dismantled by the unknown Kuki Miscreants and all my valuable properties were looted. My properties worth Rs. 11,00,000/- (rupees eleven lakh) only.

That, the delay in filling the FIR occurred due to circumstances beyond my control, such as:

- Mental shock and trauma caused by loss of home and property.
- Non-availability of documents.

That, the delay is neither intentional nor deliberate, but purely due to unavoidable and compelling circumstances arising from the Manipuri violence.

I therefore humbly pray that your good office may kindly condone the delay and register the FIR on the basis of my complaint, so that proper investigation may be carried out and justice may be rendered.

For this act of kindness, I shall remain ever grateful.
