Sir,

I have the honour to report that on 10th February, 2026 at about 3:30 pm, Smt. Kiyam Ongbi Nanaobi Devi (aged about 45 years), Smt. Khoiram Ibempishak Devi, Smt. Mentombi Nongmaithem, Chinglengamba Rajkumar, Smt. M. Malina Devi, and a minor infant aged about 2½ months were present at Lalabung Makhong. At that time, one unknown woman (whose identity can be established upon identification) suddenly rushed towards Smt. Nanaobi Devi and aggressively questioned whether she was related to me. Without any provocation whatsoever, the said unknown woman attempted to forcibly snatch the mobile phone from the hand of Smt. Nanaobi Devi. When she resisted, she was immediately subjected to physical assault. Within moments, approximately 25-30 women assembled at the spot and formed an unlawful mob. Acting in furtherance of their common intention, they collectively: (i) Physically assaulted Smt. Nanaobi Devi; (ii) Pulled her hair violently; (iii) Pushed and thrashed her; (iv) Used criminal force against her; (v) Snatched away her mobile phone; (vi) Publicly humiliated and verbally abused her. Thereafter, the mob forcibly dragged Smt. Nanaobi Devi, Smt. Ibempishak Devi, Smt. Mentombi Nongmaithem and others, including the 2½-month-old-infant, and wrongfully confined them inside the building of the local club at Lalabung Makhong by locking the premises from outside. The confinement was wholly illegal, coercive, and against their will. The minor infant was also detained inside the locked building, thereby seriously endangering the life, safety, and well-being of the child. After repeated requests and intervention, a police team from Imphal Police Station arrived and rescued Smt. Nanaobi Devi and Smt. Ibempishak Devi at about 5:30 pm. The remaining persons, including the infant, were rescued at about 7:00 pm. As a direct consequence of the brutal assault, Smt. Nanaobi Devi complained of severe pain and noticeable swelling over the right side of her head, along with persistent pain in her right thigh, hip, and lower back. She also suffered significant physical and psychological trauma due to the forceful pulling of her hair, repeated pushing, and physical thrashing by the mob. The nature and location of the injuries are consistent with the violent manner in which she was attacked. She was initially taken to RIMS Casualty, Lamphelpat, where she was registered on 10/02/2026 at 05:42 pm under UHID No. 20260036978 (Casualty Block). Thereafter, she was admitted at Raj Medicity Hospital, North AOC, under IP No. IP2026425, UHID No. 202613609, under the Department of Neurosurgery on 10/02/2026 at 09:03 pm. The Discharge Summary of Raj Medicity clearly records that she was physically assaulted by about 30 persons at Lalabung on 10.02.2026 at around 4:30 pm; she sustained a head injury; her heart rate was 101/min and blood pressure was 140/90 mmHg at admission; she required medical management under the Department of Neurosurgery; and she was discharged on 11.02.2026 at 2:14 pm with prescribed medications. These medical documents unequivocally corroborate the fact that she sustained injuries due to physical assault and required hospitalization. When the victims were escorted out from the club building by the police, the assembled mob clapped their hands and laughed mockingly in a humiliating manner, thereby further outraging their dignity and demonstrating clear criminal intent and lack of remorse. The entire incident was deliberate, coordinated, and executed by a group acting in furtherance of a common intention.

In light of the above facts, I most respectfully request that an FIR be registered forthwith under the appropriate penal provisions and other applicable laws, without any delay and that necessary legal action be taken against the persons involved.



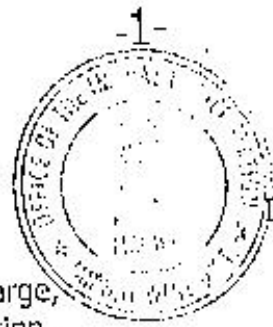

Subject: Complaint seeking registration of FIR for unlawful assembly; rioting, assault on women, robbery/snatching, wrongful confinement including a minor child, and other cognizable offences committed on 10.02.2026 at Lalambung Makhong.

Sir,

I, Smt. Khomdram Chaoba Devi, aged about 50 years, W/o Shri Khomdram Deeneshwar Singh, resident of Lalambung Makhong, P.O. & P.S. Lamphel, Imphal West District, Manipur – 795004, most respectfully submit this complaint seeking immediate registration of an FIR against the unidentified members of an unlawful mob who committed serious cognizable offences on 10.02.2026.

1. On 10th February 2026 at about 3:30 PM, Smt. Kiyam Ongbi Nanaobi Devi (aged about 45 years), Smt. Khoirum Ibempishak Devi, Smt. Memtombi Nongmaithem, Chinglengamba Rajkumar, Smt. M. Maltina Devi, and a minor infant aged about 2½ months were present at Lalambung Makhong.
2. At that time; one unknown woman (whose identity can be established upon identification) suddenly rushed towards Smt. Nanaobi Devi and aggressively questioned whether she was related to me, the complainant.
3. Without any provocation whatsoever, the said unknown woman attempted to forcibly snatch the mobile phone from the hand of Smt. Nanaobi Devi. When she resisted, she was immediately subjected to physical assault.
4. Within moments, approximately 25–30 women assembled at the spot and formed an unlawful mob. Acting in furtherance of their common intention, they collectively: (i) Physically assaulted Smt. Nanaobi Devi; (ii) Pulled her hair violently; (iii) Pushed and thrashed her; (iv) Used criminal force against her; (v) Snatched away her mobile phone; (vi) Publicly humiliated and verbally abused her.

5. Thereafter, the mob forcibly dragged Smt. Nanaobi Devi, Smt. Ibempishak Devi, Smt. Mentombi Nongmaithem and others, including the 2½-month-old infant, and wrongfully confined them inside the building of the local club at Lalambung Makhong by locking the premises from outside.

6. The confinement was wholly illegal, coercive, and against their will. The minor infant was also detained inside the locked building, thereby seriously endangering the life, safety, and well-being of the child.

7. After repeated requests and intervention, a police team from Imphal Police Station arrived and rescued Smt. Nanaobi Devi and Smt. Ibempishak Devi at about 5:30 PM. The remaining persons, including the infant, were rescued at about 7:00 PM.

8. As a direct consequence of the brutal assault, Smt. Nanaobi Devi complained of severe pain and noticeable swelling over the right side of her head, along with persistent pain in her right thigh, hip, and lower back. She also suffered significant physical and psychological trauma due to the forceful pulling of her hair, repeated pushing, and physical thrashing by the mob. The nature and location of the injuries are consistent with the violent manner in which she was attacked.

9. She was initially taken to RIMS Casualty, Lamphelpat, where she was registered on 10/02/2026 at 05:42 PM under UHID No. 20260036978 (Casualty Block). Thereafter, she was admitted at Raj Medicity Hospital, North AOC, under IP No. IP2026425, UHID No. 202613609, under the Department of Neurosurgery on 10/02/2026 at 09:03 PM.

10. The Discharge Summary of Raj Medicity clearly records that she was physically assaulted by about 30 persons at Lalambung on 10.02.2026 at around 4:30 PM; she sustained a head injury; her heart rate was 104/min and blood pressure was 140/90 mmHg at admission; she required medical management under the Department of Neurosurgery; and she was discharged on 11.02.2026 at 2:14 PM with prescribed medications. These medical documents unequivocally corroborate the fact that she sustained injuries due to physical assault and required hospitalization.

11. When the victims were escorted out from the club building by the police, the assembled mob clapped their hands and laughed mockingly in a humiliating manner, thereby further outraging their dignity and demonstrating clear criminal intent and lack of remorse. The entire



incident was deliberate, coordinated, and executed by a group acting in furtherance of a common intention.

12. From the above facts, duly supported by medical records, the following cognizable offences under the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and other applicable laws are clearly made out: unlawful assembly, rioting, voluntarily causing hurt, assault or use of criminal force against a woman, robbery/snatching of mobile phone, wrongful restraint, wrongful confinement, criminal intimidation, endangering the life and safety of a minor child, and acts done in furtherance of common intention. The wrongful confinement of women and a minor infant inside a locked building significantly aggravates the gravity of the offences.

In view of the grave and cognizable nature of the offences disclosed herein, duly corroborated by contemporaneous medical records evidencing physical assault and head injury, I most respectfully request that an FIR be registered forthwith under the appropriate penal provisions and other applicable laws, without any delay, and that necessary legal action be taken against the persons involved.

I am ready to cooperate fully in the investigation.
