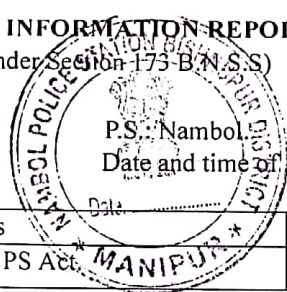

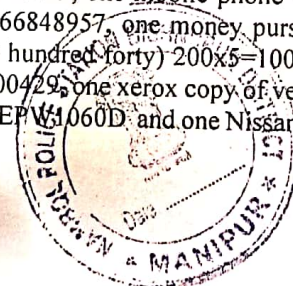

Sir,

With due regards, I have the honour to state that today i.e. 28/11/2025 at 7:00 am, a joint operational team was conducting a random Mobile Vehicle Check Post (MVCP) along the stretch of Tiddim Road between Malom and Keinou. The team comprised personnel from the Nambol Police Station, led by Inspector A. Nabakanta Sharma, OC/NBL-P.S, SI. K. Jiban Singh, ASI. T. Premananda Singh, myself & HC. N.Gopen Singh of NBL-PS and the MN Sector QAT and Range Sector QAT of the CRPF, led by Loukrakpam Ibomcha Singh, Assistant Commandant, 109 BN CRPF. The entire MVCP was conducted under the overall supervision of SP/BPR, Thokchom Shankar Deba, MPS.

While putting random mobile checking point at Utlou Koubiliya Makhong opposite Car wash Centre of Loitongbam Jadumani Singh of Utlou Mayai at around 7:50 am, one Nissan Maganite car, grey in colour bearing regd. No. NL07CB 4712 which was proceeding from Churachandpur side towards Imphal side along Tiddim road was observed driving in a suspicious manner toward the checking teams. The vehicle was signalled to halt and was successfully stopped. On spot verification, the driver identified himself as V Willingson (29 years) S/O D Visale of Laii village, P.O-Tadubi, P.S- Tungjoy, Senapati, Manipur (driver of the vehicle). Due to his suspicious nature and in order to check his body and belongings, he was given option whether he wanted to check his body and belongings in front of a Gazetted Officer or Magistrate. In that, he opted to be searched in presence of Executive Magistrate. Accordingly, contacted concern Executive Magistrate Shri Th. Shambhunath, SDC/Executive Magistrate, Nambol. Thereafter, the Executive Magistrate reached within a short period at the spot and his body and belongings were searched and checked minutely. While checking the vehicle, 70 (seventy) nos. of soap cases suspected to Heroin No.4 were found kept concealed beneath the rear bumper of the said Nissan Maganite. The suspected contraband Heroin No.4 were seized in presence of the Magistrate and witnesses at 8:30 am at the spot. Thereafter, the above seized items were kept inside a carton box by wrapping a white cloth and also packed and sealed with using facsimile seal of NBL-PS by observing necessary formalities and marked as X. Further, seized one Aadhar Card bearing No. 789017316359, one mobile phone One plus along with two SIM cards bearing mobile Nos. 7085646396 & 9366848957, one money purse black in colour with Indian currency RS, 1140/-(rupees one thousand one hundred forty) 200x5=1000, 100x1=100/-& 20x2= 40/-, one driving licence bearing No. MN0820210000429, one xerox copy of vehicle registration certificate of NL07CB 4712, one PAN Card bearing No. AHEPW1060D and one Nissan Maganite car, Silver in colour



bearing regd. No. NL07CB 4712 at 8:35 am on production by V Willingson (29 years) S/O D Visale of Laii village, P.O-Tadubi, P.S- Tungjoy, Senapati, Manipur by observing due formalities.

Accordingly, the accused persons namely V. Willingson was arrested at 8:50 am, from the spot by observing necessary formalities. On preliminary interrogation, he disclosed that, he is a drug peddler and the said items are contraband Heroin No.4 which was brought from one girl of Lajangphai village, Churchandpur for selling to some prospective buyer at Senapati.

Accordingly, the arrested persons and the seized items were handed over to Nambol Police for taking further necessary action.
