Respected Sir,

1. Based on credible input individuals associated with banned insurgent groups moving in a light vehicle towards IMB. MVCP was established by Assam Rifles at Chassad (kamjong) near playground at 14 30 hrs on 30th December, 2025.

2.A Toyota Fortuner Regn no MN 01 as 9471 with four passengers was seen approaching the MVCP at around 1500 hrs. Same was intercepted and the suspected individuals were questioned. On preliminary enquiry the individuals exhibited suspicious behavior. Subsequently all four individuals were detained for further enquiry.

On examination of mobiles of the individuals, photographic and videographic evidences indicated suspects involvement in unlawful and anti-national activities like drug smuggling, smuggling of bio hazard/radioactive materials and documents of highly confidential nature pertaining to agencies like Bhabha atomic research centre and Indian iridium research enterprises pvt ltd were found. The individuals

were not able to produce any relevant documents of the above-mentioned vehicle and it seems that they are using a stolen vehicle.

4.Deleted videos of month wise experiments with huge quantity of unknown bio hazard materials and advanced research documents on the subject were recovered by the team of assam rifles. Further investigation revealed links with individuals named Gulzar Ali Barbhuiya of Hailakandi, Silchar, Masuk Ahmed Barbhuyia of Hailakandi, Silchar, Rajen Paumei of Imphal (presently located in silchar) and Awomi Sema of Dimapur all of them involved in smuggling of chemical from Bangladesh and advanced experimentation in unknown location approximately 25 km from Hailakandi, Silchar. Further photographs also revealed huge quantity of cash, drugs and bio hazard chemicals.

The suspects on enquiry further revealed the following:

5.1 cartel of smuggling of bio hazard chemical from Bangladesh Via Silchar and further being transported to Dimapur.

5.2 testing and experiment of likely bio hazard materials which was smuggled from across Bangladesh to Hailakandi, Silchar. As per statement of the individuals the bio hazard materials have highly poisoning potential and same was to be further tested by few scientists in near future.

Hence, the alleged accused persons namely I Raigam s/o I Shailei, Shagrei phao Ngalung. Chance Shokwungnao and Thangjam herojit singh were arrested at 1540 hrs, 1545 hrs, 1550 hrs and 1600 hrs respectively. And their mobile phones iphone 14 pro (8131894310) and one Toyota Fortuner, Regn no - MN 01 as 9471, samsung m33 (9366300434), samsung s25 ultra (8787576821) and redmi 9a (8787655616) were seized at 1610 hrs, 1615 hrs, 1620 hrs and 1625 hrs respectively from their possession.

In view of the above, it is requested to lodge a first information report (fir) under relevant provisions of law against the suspects mentioned above and to initiate a thorough investigation into the recovered digital materials, and take necessary action in national interests.

On examination of mobiles of the individuals, photographic and videographic evidences indicated suspects involvement in unlawful and anti-national activities like Drug smuggling, smuggling of bio hazard/radioactive materials and documents of highly confidential nature pertaining to agencies like Bhabha Atomic Research Centre and Indian Iridium Research Enterprises Pvt Ltd were found. The individuals were not able to produce any relevant documents of the above mentioned vehicle and it seems that they are using a stolen vehicle.


