Upon reaching Sehken village, the team noticed a white Maruti Gypsy in suspicious circumstances and attempted to stop the vehicle. However, the vehicle sped away, prompting the team to give chase. The vehicle was eventually intercepted near Hiangtam village. During on-the-spot enquiry, the occupants revealed that they had concealed suspected brown sugar by the roadside of Hiangtam village. Acting on this information, the team took them to the indicated location. Upon reaching the spot, 45 soap cases suspected to contain brown sugar were found concealed. The items were recovered and seized by the mobile team on production by the suspected accused persons. The individuals were identified as H. Kamtunmung (50 years), son of late Thangchinkap, and Paulianlal (49 years), son of Paukhanthang, both residents of Vengnuom, Singngat.
