Sir,

With Ref. to SP-CCP order No. B-16/14/SP-CCP/2012/344 dated 22nd January, 2026, a team of Police from Singngat-PS, Behiang-PS and Reserve Line-CCP along with representatives from the DFO-CCP, Assam Rifles, 1st IRB, NAB-CCP and the concerned Executive Magistrate led by Shri. K. Paukhenthang, MPS, SDPO-SGT under the supervision of SP-CCP were detailed to carry out destruction of illicit opium poppy cultivation at Zoukhonum Hill Range under Singngat Sub-Division, on 23-01-2026. There, the Executive Magistrate, Singngat furnished attachment and destruction order of the illicit poppy cultivation in the said area u/s 48 of ND&PS Act, 1985 (as amended).

Then the combine team proceeded from Singngat PS at around 10:00AM and reached Zoukhonum village hill range i.e where illicit poppy was cultivated at around 12:30PM of the day. The area of the land where poppy was cultivated is approximately estimated to be 15(fifteen) Acres. The cultivation is on the top and slopes of the ridge and vastly cultivated far away from the view of the people around the area. No one came forward to claim the ownership of the cultivation.

Then, we examined the plants systematically and confirmed that, the same was opium poppy plants. Some of the poppy pod/flowering top was cut with a sharp blade which produces white milky fluid. On closure examination, it was found that, in a 1/1 meter area, there were about 30 plants. Hence, 5(five) poppy pods have been seized in which 3(three) poppy pod is extracted for original sample and the remaining 2(two) poppy pods kept for duplicate sample. The original samples and duplicate sample were packed and sealed in an envelope each marked as 'A' and 'B' respectively. Then, the witnesses put signature on the collected seized samples. Then, the illicit poppy were cut down/uprooted and burnt as per provision of law. The destructed area is expected to yield about 75 kgs of opium. Details of the photography before, during and after destruction were taken for adducing evidence if required in the Court of law.

Therefore, report is submitted along with the seized articles for further necessary action.
