With reference to the endorsement in c/w the above given GD No, I have visited the Office of Chief Medical Officer, Churachandpur and conducted a preliminary enquiry under Rules i.e under section 173(3) of BNSS.

That, as per enquiry it is found that there was a burglary activities and theft within the campus of CMO/CCPur continuously on the night of 3rd and 4th January, 2026. On 3rd January, 2026, the unknown miscreants entered the office of the Chief Medical Officer through the main door by breaking the lock and had stolen one Stan Fan kept inside the Office chamber of CMI/CCPur. The unknown culprit had also damaged the door lock of Food Safety and Staff Room of DACO office. However, there is no report of stolen properties from the above mentioned two office. There was another burglary on the 4th January, 2026 in which two room (locked) where properties and belonging of MBBS & GNM displaced students were kept was destroyed. However there is no los of any properties and belonging. The same night the unknown miscreants had stolen a vehicle battery of GNM School bus and diesels from ALS ambulance as well as of CMO vehicle.

I, Inspector Thangpu Tosing, OC/CCP-PS, do hereby request you to allow a preliminary enquiry into the matter of complaint submitted by Dr. T. Vanlalkungi, CMO-CCPur vide Memo No. Misc/94-CMO(Ch):/293 Dated: 05/01/2026 regarding burglary activities and theft within CMO campus and GNM School of Nursing, Churachandpur, occurred continuously on the unpleasant nights of the 03rd and 04th January, 2026 respectively.

Furthermore, the CMO stated that the door lock of the office of CMO, Office of the Food Safety and Staff Room of DACO was damaged and the unknown culprit entered the Office Rooms. The Stand Fan kept in CMO's Chamber was found missing while the back doors of Malaria Department and CMO Chamber were not latched. Continuously, on the night of 4th January, 2026 another burglary breaking through at PMJVK Building of GNM School of Nursing, Churachandpur, occurred where two rooms (locked) belonging to MBBS and GNM displaced students was found open without any loss of items/School materials. However, on the same night the unknown culprits stole the vehicle battery of GNM School Bus and Diesels from ALS Ambulance as well as CMO Official Vehicle.

In this regard, for ascertaining genuineness of the complaint, a preliminary enquiry is highly required to be conducted. Additionally, needs thorough verification of the facts and gathering initial information to determine if there is a prima facie case.

I request you to kindly allow a preliminary enquiry under Rules i.e. Under Section 173(3) of the B.N.S.S. and take necessary action as deemed fit.

Subject : Report and Lodge an FIR on burglary activities and theft within current CMO Campus and GNM School of Nursing, Churachandpur

Sir,

With reference to the above cited subject, I would like to give a Report that, a daring burglary activities by breaking through the Office Locks of Offices within CMO Campus and GNM School of Nursing, Churachandpur, occurred continuously on the unpleasant nights of 3rd and 4th January 2026.

The matter of burglary breakthrough first came to light on Sunday, the 4th January 2026, around 9:00 AM, when the Health Staff on Post-Mortem Duty came for Official Duty. On this day, it was learned that, the door lock of the Office of CMO, Office of the Food Safety and Staff Room of DACO were damaged and the unknown culprit entered the Office Rooms. On this day, the Stand Fan kept in CMO's Chamber was found missing while the Back doors of Malaria Department and CMO Chamber were not latched. Most Police personnel's on Post-Mortem duty also have thorough knowledge on the matter.

Continuously on the night of 4th January 2026, another burglary breakthrough at PMJVK Building of GNM School of Nursing, Churachandpur, occurred where two rooms (locked) belonging to MBBS & GNM displaced Students was found Open without any loss of items/School materials. On the same night the unknown culprit stole the Vehicle Battery of GNM School Bus and Diesels from ALS Ambulance as well as of CMO Official Vehicle.

Therefore, I would request you to Lodge an FIR for the same and earnestly request you for providing safety measures by conducting routine ROP Duty in regular interval in these areas i.e. Campus of CMO & GNM School of Nursing.
