I, Khwairakpam Ibotombi Singh, aged about 63 years s/o Late Kh. Angou Singh, resident of Laipham Khunou Mamang Leikai, PO. Lamlong, P.S. Lamphel, Imphal East District, Manipur, do hereby most respectfully submit this complaint for registration of a Zero FIR in respect of my missing commercial vehicle and another similarly situated vehicle, which disappeared during the outbreak of ethnic violence at Churachandpur District in May 2023. As I am unable to approach the jurisdictional Police Station at Churachandpur due to prevailing Buffer zone restrictions and security concerns, I am constrained to lodge the present complaint to lodge the present complaint before your Police Station for necessary registration and onward transmission in accordance with law.

### 1. Particulars of the Vehicles

- 1.1 Vehicle No. MN06-T-1372-Tata 12-Wheeler Truck registered in my name, Khwairakpam Ibotombi Singh, worth about Rs. 25,00000 (Rupees Twenty-Five Lakhs).
- 1.2 Vehicle No. MN06-T-1373-Tata 12-Wheeler Truck registered in the name of Khwairakpam Ibungo Meitei, aged about 40 years, s/o Late Kh. Ibomcha Meitei worth about Rs. 25,00000 (Rupees Twenty-Five Lakhs). At the time of purchase, he was a resident of Langol Lairembi, P.O & P.S. Lamphel, Imphal West District, Manipur and is presently residing at Langjing Ching Manipur, P.O. Langjing, P.S. Patsoi, Imphal West District, Manipur.

## 2 Nature of Engagement and Official Assignment

- 2.1 The aforesaid vehicles were engaged as commercial transport vehicles for lifting and transportation of rice under the Public Distribution Sysytem (PDS).
- 2.2 The vehicles were deployed from time to time for the transportation of rice from Jiribam to Imphal and from Imphal to Churachandpur under assignments issued by the Food Corporation of India (FCI) and the consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution Department, Government of Manipur.

## 3 Events Leading to the Loss of Vehicles

- 3.1 In the Month of April 2023, prior to the outbreak of Large-Scale ethnic violence in Manipur on 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2023, both the vehicles were assigned to transport NFSA rice from FCI Godown/CAF& PD Godown to designated distribution centres in Churachandpur District.
- 3.2 During the course of such assignment , the said vehicles reached Churachandpur and were parked inside the DIET Office Complex at Churachandpur.
- 3.3 On 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2023, widespread ethnic violence across various district of Manipur, including Churachandpur. The situation rapidly deteriorated with incidents of arson, looting, destruction of public and private properties, imposition of curfew, suspension of internet services, and severe restrictions of movement.
- 3.4 During the said unrest and mob violence, essential commodities, including rice loaded in several trucks were reportedly looted, and the law and order situation completely collapsed in the area.
- 3.5 Since the eruption of violence, the aforesaid vehicles bearing Registration Nos. MN06-T-1372 and MN06-T-1373 did not return from Churachandpur, and their whereabouts have remained unknown till date.

## 4 Efforts made to Trace the Vehicles

- 4.1 I have approached various concerned authorities including officials of CAF&PD and other responsible persons to ascertain the whereabouts of the vehicles.
- 4.2 I was informed that due to the prevailing crisis and volatile situation, no effective steps could be taken immediately but that necessary measures would be undertaken after restoration of normalcy.
- 4.3 However, despite the lapse of more than two years since May 2023, the vehicles remain untraceable and no definite information has been received regarding their location or condition.

## 5 Explanation Regarding Delay in Lodging the complaint

- 5.1 The delay in lodging the present complaint is neither intentional nor deliberate. Immediately after the outbreak of ethnic violence on 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2023, there was complete disruption of normal life in Manipur.
- 5.2 Strict curfews were imposed, mobile internet services were suspended, and buffer zones were established between the hill and valley districts, severely restricting inter-district movement, particularly between Imphal and Churachandpur.
- 5.3 Due to grave concerns for personal safety, lack of transportation facilities, communication breakdown, and continued tension in the affected areas, it was practically impossible for me to travel to Churachandpur to lodge a complaint before the jurisdictional Police Station.
- 5.4 Moreover, I was repeatedly assured by concerned officials that efforts would be made to locate and recover the vehicles once normalcy was restored.
- 5.5 In view of the extraordinary and unprecedented circumstances prevailing in the State since May 2023, I could not immediately lodge a formal complaint. The present report is therefore being submitted at the earliest possible opportunity when circumstanes have reasonably permitted.

## 6 Cause of Action and Legal Request

- 6.1 The disappearance of the vehicles under the circumstanes described above gives rise to a cognizable offence, including but not limited to theft, misappropriation, criminal breach of trust, or any other offence as may be revealed during inestigation.

6.2 As the occurrence took place within the territorial jurisdiction of Churachandpur District and due to my inability to approach the concerned Police Station there owing to security and buffer zone restrictions, I respectfully request that this complainst be treated as a Zero FIR.

### Prayer

In the light of the above facts and circumstances, I most respectfully pray that your good office may kindly:-

- (a) Register a Zero FIR in connection with the missing vehicles bearing Registration Nos. MN06-T-1372 and MN06-T-1373;
- (b) Initiate necessary investigation un der relevant provision of law; and
- (c) Forward the registered FIR to the competent jurisdictional Police Station at Churachandpur District for further investigation in accordance with law.

I undertake to cooperate fully with the investigation and to produce all relevant documents such as Registration Certificates, insurance papers, finance documents, and official assignment records as and when required.

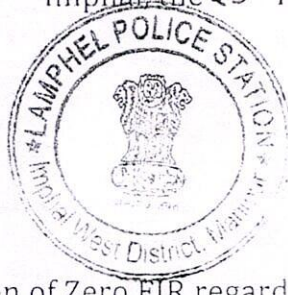



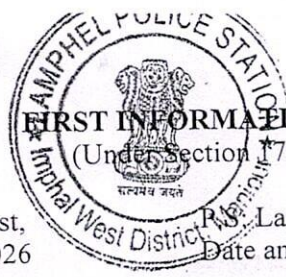

#### **6. Cause of Action and Legal Request**

6.1 The disappearance of the vehicles under the circumstances described above gives rise to a cognizable offence, including but not limited to theft, misappropriation, criminal breach of trust, or any other offence as may be revealed during investigation.

6.2 As the occurrence took place within the territorial jurisdiction of Churachandpur District and due to my inability to approach the concerned Police Station there owing to security and buffer zone restrictions, I respectfully request that this complaint be treated as a Zero FIR.

#### **Prayer**

In the light of the above facts and circumstances, I most respectfully pray that your good office may kindly:-

(a) Register a Zero FIR in connection with the missing vehicles bearing Registration Nos. MN06-T-1372 and MN06-T-1373;

(b) Initiate necessary investigation under relevant provisions of law; and

(c) Forward the registered FIR to the competent jurisdictional Police Station at Churachandpur District for further investigation in accordance with law.

I undertake to cooperate fully with the investigation and to produce all relevant documents such as Registration Certificates, insurance papers, finance documents, and official assignment records as and when required.




