Sir,

It is submitted that on 25/03/2026 fm 1840 hrs 01 Sec of C/129 Bn U/C Bull Aman Tomar was deployed at Old SP Office to perform Joint mobile team duty. As per direction of civil police, deployed Sec at Old SP Office U/C Bull Aman Tomar a/w Subedar Thangboi of Civil Police (5MR) with team left from Old SP Office around 1900 hrs and reached at Tuibong Market Traffic point where a crowd of 50-60 civilians was already agitating near 19 Garhwal MPV vehicle and civil police was trying to control the mob. In between said Army Vehicle left from there and the mob got violent and started heavy stone pelting, one of the stone struck the civil driver namely, Ayub Khan of civil vehicle winger registration No. MN 01 SW-1284 who sustained head injury on right side of his head and he could not drive the vehicle. To save themselves from heavy stone pelting the party and the driver left the spot in hurry leaving behind Anjali suit, poly carbonate shield and lathi and in the confusion Force No. 125253642 CT/GD Shashikant Patond accidentally left behind one of his Insas Rifle Magazine with 20 rounds with it in the veh. The mob pelted, overturned and torched the winger veh.

The party Commander Bull Aman Tomar informed the Company Commander immediately and coy commander also informed Commandant. Thereafter, Shri Manmadhan Krishnan (Commandant), Shri Saurav Kumar (Deputy Commandant) with Dett QAT and Zebra Vinod Kumar Singh (Coy Commander) of C/129 Bn with Coy QAT reached the spot and dispersed the stone pelting civilians by firing shells. By that time, the civil vehicle winger

registration no. MN 01 S-1284 was fully engulfed in flames along with the above mentioned govt stores. After few minutes Shri Gaurav Dogra, IPS, SP Churachandpur also reached the spot and succeeded in dispersing and rounded up about 32 miscreants crowd. Currently the situation is under control. During the stone pelting incident following quantity of shells was fired:-

01. Long Range Shell- 21 nos (QAT Dett/ 129 Bn-06 Nos and C/129 Bn-15 Nos)
02. Short range shell- 10 Nos (C/129 Bn)
03. Ballastic cartridge- 09 Nos (C/129 Bn)
