Today, i.e. 10th April 2026 at 07:15 AM, received reliable inputs from own sources and 19 Garhwal regarding movement of armed cadres in close proximity to sensitive zones. Immediately dynamic joint MVCPS were set up and joint teams of CCP Police and 19 Garhwal rushed to intercept the armed miscreants. During surveillance, two DI bearing numbers NL01 AF- 6831 and MZ01 AC- 9716 were found to be being driven in a very suspicious manner. On spotting the security forces the said vehicles sped up and tried to evade the security forces when they were asked to stop. On seeing the suspicious behaviour, joint teams started chasing the said vehicles. On repeated non-compliance to lawful directives and sensing an impending threat to public life and property by the way the target vehicles were being driven the teams were forced to fire warning shots in the air. Consequently, the vehicles came to an halt at T Bangla MVCP of 19 Garhwal. On verification 2 person were found to be inside the two vehicles. On personal search 2 weapons were recovered from their possession. From the vehicles 36 sacks suspected to be containing poppy seeds were also recovered. The two individuals namely, 1) Letjakai Haokip (32) s/o Hemjathang Haokip of Sarang Tampak, Chakpikarong, Chandel. A/P Thingkangphai, Churachandpur 2) Lunkhohao Haokip (40) s/o Khaisei Haokip of V.
