Sub: Submission of Enquiry Report U/S 173(3) BNSS

Sir,

I have the honour to submit the following report in connection with the complaint report submitted by one Dr. Md. Anash Khan, aged about 32 years, S/o (L) Abdul Salam, resident of Phundrei Awang Leikai, P.O. Wangjing, P.S. Khongjom, District Thoubal, Manipur, to the Officer-in-Charge, Khongjom Police Station on 15/02/2026, which referred with above mentioned GD Entry for necessary action.

That the complainant stating that on 12th February, 2026 at around 6.00 pm while the complainant namely Dr. Md Anash Khan was away from his home, two individuals namely 1) Dr. Muzamil Khan aged about 48 years s/o Subhanudin resident of Khetrigao Keikhu Chanam Awang Leikai a/p at a rental house of Niyaz Khan of Hatta Eta Khola Imphal East and 2) Md. Farid Shah aged about 26 years s/o Md Salatur Rahaman resident of Khergao Awang Leikai PO/PS: Porompat District: Imphal East arrived at his house. According to his sister, who was present at that time, the two individuals behaved in an aggressive and threatening manner. They demanded that his sister should handover the complainant (i.e., Dr. Md Anash Khan) to them and they also made the highly offensive and false allegation that his wife is actually the wife of one of the accused (i.e. Md. Farid Shah). After a heated argument with his sister, the duo left a letter addressed to the complainant. This letter summons the complainant to appear before them at 11:00 pm on February 16, 2026. The conduct of Dr. Muzamil Khan and Farid Shah has caused immense mental agony and fear for the safety of the complainant's family, especially considering the late-hour "summons" and the baseless claims regarding his wife. Their actions appear to be a clear attempt at criminal intimidation and a threat to peace. The complainant earnestly request the OC Khongjom PS to: 1. Register an FIR against Dr. Muzamil Khan and Farid Shah under the relevant sections of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS). 2. Take necessary legal action to ensure the safety of the complainant's family and himself. 3. To investigate the motives behind the letter and their unauthorized presence at the complainant's home. The complainant has attached a copy/the original letter left by the accused for reference and he is ready to cooperate fully with the investigation.

In this regard, it was considered necessary to conduct a preliminary enquiry under Section 173(3) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with reference to the complaint report. Accordingly, permission to conduct the preliminary enquiry was sought from the Dy.SP/SDPO, Thoubal, who was pleased to permit the conduct of a discreet enquiry in connection with the above GD Entry. On receipt of the said permission, the same was endorsed to the undersigned for conducting the enquiry and submitting the report at the earliest.

During the course of enquiry, the place of occurrence was visited and a rough sketch map of the place of occurrence along with index was prepared. During the spot enquiry, the complainant and his elder sister namely Mrs. Roujatun (38 years) w/o Amar Hussain of Yaripok Changamdabi, Imphal East, were examined and their statements were recorded on separate sheets. Both of them corroborated the contents of the complaint report.

Further, notices under Section 35 of the BNSS, 2023 were served upon the alleged accused persons namely: Dr. Muzamil Khan (48 years), S/o Subhanudin, resident of Khetrigao Keikhu Chanam Awang Leikai, presently staying at a rented house of Niyaz Khan at Hatta Eta Khola, Imphal East and Md. Farid Shah (26 years), S/o Md. Salatur Rahaman, resident of Khergao Awang Leikai, P.O./P.S. Porompat, District Imphal East. They were directed to appear before this Police Station on 16/02/2026

and 21/02/2026 respectively, however both the alleged accused persons have failed to appear before the Police Station till date.

During the enquiry, it was learnt that the alleged accused Dr. Muzamil Khan had served a notice directing the complainant to appear before his office namely "Human Rights International Federation" located at Hafiz Hatta Intakhola, Imphal East on 16th February, 2026 at about 11:00 PM in connection with a purported matrimonial dispute complaint allegedly submitted by Md. Farid Shah. Upon reviewing the notice, it was stated that a copy was also addressed to the Officer-in-Charge, Khongjom Police Station, however this police station has not received any such copy from Dr. Muzamil Khan to date. This lack of receipt by the police station raises reasonable doubt about the authenticity of the notice.

Based on the statements of the complainant and witnesses, spot verification, and other materials collected during the course of the preliminary enquiry, it is revealed that the alleged accused persons namely Dr. Muzamil Khan and Md. Farid Shah had visited the residence of the complainant in his absence and behaved in an aggressive and threatening manner towards the complainant's sister. They also made baseless and defamatory allegations regarding the complainant's wife and left a letter directing the complainant to appear before them at late night hours at the office of an organisation namely "Human Rights International Federation", Hafiz Hatta Intakhola, Imphal East.

The enquiry further revealed that the notice issued by Dr. Muzamil Khan appears to have been served without any lawful authority, thereby misleading the complainant and attempting to create an impression of official authority. The act of summoning the complainant during late night hours and making threatening and defamatory allegations has caused fear, intimidation, and mental harassment to the complainant and his family members.

Moreover, despite service of notices under Section 35 BNSS, the alleged accused persons have failed to appear before the Police Station, which further raises suspicion regarding their conduct. The delay in submission of the enquiry report was mainly due to the inconvenience faced in recording their statements and so it is necessary to proceed with the investigation of the matter.

Therefore, from the above facts and circumstances, it is revealed that during the preliminary enquiry, prima facie cognizable offences appear to have been committed by the accused persons punishable under Sections 351 (Criminal Intimidation), 352 (Intentional Insult with intent to provoke breach of peace), 319(2) (Cheating by personation/impersonating authority), 356 (Defamation) read with Section 3(5) (Common intention) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

Hence, it is considered fit and proper to register a regular FIR against the accused persons and take up investigation as per law. Submitted this enquiry report for favour of kind perusal and necessary action please.
