Subject: - Report.

Sir,

I have the honour to report that today i.e. 17/02/2026 in the morning a combine team of Mao-PS and SOT-Senapati was conducting random frisking and checking at Punanamei-Asufii/Kedima junction. At around 4.00 am, one Alto Car bearing Regd. No. AS12D-8958 Silver colour heading towards Kedima was stopped by the teams for checking. However, the driver of the vehicle refused to comply and speed away. So, our team immediately sprang into action, pursuing the fleeing vehicle. While chasing the suspected vehicle dash twice on the SOT vehicle, trying to push the police vehicle down the gorge threatening the lives of the police personnel on duty. Therefore 3 blank fire of 9 mm Pistol was shot as a warning to the driver to stop the vehicle. However the driver did not stop the vehicle and hit the police car again, thereby as no alternative was left, one more round of 9 mm was fired at the right front wheel of the vehicle.

After an intense chase of about 2 km between Punanamei and Kedima Village, we found the Alto come to halt at a distance ahead, we rushed forward, only to discover that the driver had evaded capture, leaving the vehicle and escaped into surrounding dark forest. These raised our suspicion that the driver may have been involved in illicit activities. Upon conducting a thorough inspection of the vehicle we found a bag containing some suspected opium. On confirming the presence of drug in the vehicle, Executive Magistrate was intimated and a request was made for carrying out formalities. Accordingly ADM/MAO Shri. Rang David Kung (Executive Magistrate), Song Song. On his arrival, thoroughly checking the vehicle, one bag containing 1 (one) packet of suspected Opium was found concealed below the rear seat of the vehicle. The 1 (one) packet of suspected opium were weighed using the digital weighing machine in presence of Executive Magistrate and witnesses with video coverage as per BNSS. The consignment found to be the weight of 1.05 Kgs including the weight of plastic packet. The approximate value is 5,25,000/- five lakhs twenty-five thousands) only. The 1 (one) packet of suspected opium were seized in the presence of Executive Magistrate and witnesses by preparing a seizure memo at 10.30 am at the spot by observing formalities.

Particulars of the seized items:-

1. One bag containing 1 (one) packet of suspected to opium weighing 1.05 Kgs including the weight of plastic packet and one SBI Passbook bearing A/C No. 37877050165 in the name of Mr. Kevipuzo Rote S/o Vilesul Rote of Daklane Colony, Sector-III, Kohima Sadar.
2. One Alto car bearing Regd. No. AS12D-8958 silver in colour along with Key.
3. One Mobile Phone (Redme) bearing IMEI1-864985061622301, IMEI2-864985061622319 alongwith one SIM Card, Airtel No. 9362564160.
4. A pair of sandal (Cross)
