Prakash Singh of CDO Unit Kakching with a joint naka party of District Police Kakching and Kakching Police Station team led by SI Govinda Khundongbam under the command of Sub. S. Birla Singh, OC/CDO Kakching, and under the supervision of Shri Amarjit Singh Lamabam, MPS, Addl. SP (Ops), Kakching, and under the overall supervision of Smt. Priyadarshini Lalshram, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Kakching District were conducted frisking and checking at Pallel Laimanai Chingjin area for precautionary checking and one Passenger Bus bearing Registration No. MN- 01 2222 having the name 'SINRUWNG' coming from Kakching Lamkhai side towards Pallel side was intercepted for routine frisking and checking at Pallel Laimanai Chingjin area. All the passenger of the said Bus were verified and checked one after another. On checking, two suspected passenger women were detained in presence of women CDOs for proper verification and identified themselves as (i) Th. Vini (52)yrs W/o Paresh Jajo of Liwa Leikun Village, Liwa Sarei, Chandel District and (ii) Ayola Shinglai (55)yrs W/o (L) Huimikan Shinglai of Liwa Leikun Village, Liwa Sarei, Chandel District.

In order to ensure fairness, transparency and strict compliance with legal procedure, the two ladies were clearly informed of their legal right under Section 50 of the NDPS Act that they could be searched in the presence of a Civil witness or Magistrate or a Gazetted Officer, if they so desired. After being so informed, the detained ladies voluntarily expressed their willingness and opted that the search and further proceedings be conducted in the presence of a civil witness. Accordingly, the driver of the said passenger bus was called in and after confirming the willingness of the two ladies, further proceedings were conducted in presence of the civil witness.

On checking the belongings of Th. Vini (52)yrs W/o Paresh Jajo of Liwa Leikun Village, Liwa Sarei, Chandel District, one black colour plastic polythene containing 12(twelve) strips of suspected SP capsules having 24 pieces each in each strips having the marked 'SEMPLEX+' along with one mobile phone Realme 14X 5G having one Airtel Sim Card bearing No. 8730804649 was recovered. On further checking of the belongings of Ayola Shinglai (55)yrs W/o (L) Huimikan Shinglai of Liwa Leikun Village, Liwa Sarei, Chandel District, another mobile phone Redmi Note 7 black colour having one Airtel Sim Card bearing No. 9862862539 was recovered. All the recovered strips containing suspected SP capsules were counted without breaking the strips as it is clearly visible and found to be 288 pieces. Thereafter, the recovered items were formally seized at 4.50 pm and 4.53 pm respectively on their productions and the same were videographed in presence of civil witness.

At the place of recovery, the 12(twelve) numbers of strips containing suspected SP capsules were packed inside a mobile cover box and was wrapped by a transparent plastic tap.

On preliminary questioning about the recovered suspected SP capsules, the two ladies disclosed that the said suspected SP capsules were taken from unknown person at Kakching Lamkhai and will be distributing 6 strips each among themselves. But, both of them is refused to disclose the particulars of the unknown persons whom they have taken those SP capsules.

Accordingly, the two ladies was formally arrested at 5.05 pm and 5.10 pm respectively in presence of the civil witness and lady CDO from the spot by observing all legal formalities and was informed of the grounds of arrest and their legal rights. Immediate intimation regarding their arrest and place of detention was conveyed to their relative respectively. The arrested ladies and all seized articles were then brought to Kakching Police Station for further necessary legal action.

The above acts prima facie constitute offences under the provisions of the NDPS Act and other relevant laws. Hence, this complaint is submitted for kindly registering a case, taking up investigation and doing the needful as per law.

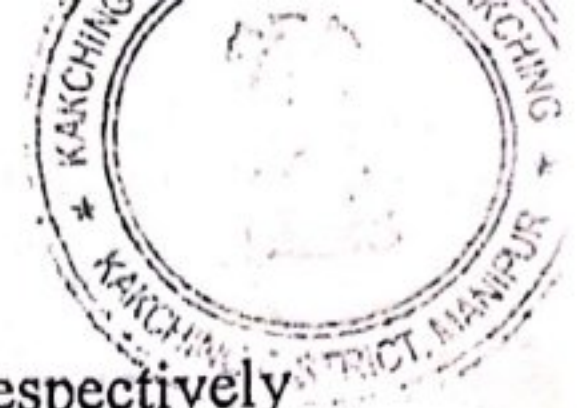
