Sir,

With reference to the above cited subject, I have the honor to submit herewith inquiry report for kind perusal and further necessary action.

The brief fact of the case is that on 27/02/2026 the complainant namely Heisnam Merina Devi W/o H. Ratan Singh of Singjamel Thokchou Leikai lodged a written report to OC Imphal PS stating that on 23/02/2026 her husband namely H. Ratan Singh, along with one Gurumayum Nelson Sharma, aged about 29 years, S/o G. Sharat Sharma of Kwakeithel Laishram Leikai, Imphal West District, Manipur, and her minor son namely Heisnam Denim, aged about 16 years, had been attacked by a mob led by one Bikash and his relatives and local friends by criminally trespassing her house with firearms with an attempt to murder which caused grievous injury to Gurumayum Nelson Sharma with cordrum injury. The issue arose after a dispute regarding the placing of the dead body of the said main accused Bikash's mother.

That during the arguments, a mob consisting of approximately 60-70 persons, led by one Bikash, aged about 30 years unlawfully assembled at the spot and began creating serious law and order problems. That without any provocation, the said mob started physically assaulting her minor son Heisnam Denim and her nephew Gurumayum Nelson Sharma was also brutally attacked which caused grievous injury over his cordrum. They were mercilessly beaten, dragged and humiliated in public view, causing serious physical injuries and mental trauma her husband H. Ratan Singh was also pushed violently and fell to the ground during the assault and one of the relatives of the said Bikash took out a pistol gun and openly threatened her husband and others with dire consequences.

The said mob deliberately destroyed four CCTV cameras installed at the spot. The destruction of the cameras was intentional and aimed at suppressing evidence of the crime committed by them. A meeting was held to arrive at an amicable settlement. However, no resolution could be reached on the contrary an FIR was registered against my husband. Subsequently, the police team took my husband, my minor son and Gurumayum Nelson Sharma for illegal use of arms and other allegations. They are victims of mob violence and not perpetrators of any offence. Further, a huge valuable item including cash, jewellery and other valuable items are lost. Hence, an inquiry has been conducted in this regard.

During the course of inquiry, the complainant was examined very carefully and minutely and recorded her statement. Visited the spot and inspected very carefully and minutely. The CCTV footages of the scene of crime dated 23/02/2026 was collected and on checking the CCTV footages, it was found that the complainant's minor son closed the main gate to stop his cousin brother H. Bikash to bring the dead body of her mother inside the house of the complainant along with his friends and family members numbering about 30/40 members. But the irate mob forcefully entered inside the building of the complainant and started confrontation with the complainant's husband. It was also found that the mob assaulted Nelson Sharma on the road. The mob forcefully entered inside the building of the complainant and started confrontation with the complainant husband namely Heisnam Ratan Singh and he fell down on the floor as he was pushed down by the mob and the situation got worsened. The husband of the complainant H. Ratan Singh took out pistol from his waist and fired one live round from his firearm in the ceiling to control the mob.

In the CCTV footage, it was also found that one unknown person (relatives of the alleged accused person H. Bikash) took out one small fire arm and threatens the complainant and her family members.

As such, during the course inquiry it has been ascertained that the alleged accused person namely H. Bikash along with his associates committed the cognizable offenses including house trespass, attempt to murder, hurt, unlawful assembly, rioting, mischief causing damage, destruction of evidence and criminal intimidation.

It, is therefore submitted this report for kind perusal and further necessary action to register a regular FIR at the earliest.
