Sir,

On today, i.e., 17/05/2026 at about 4:30 PM, reliable information was received regarding the delivery of contraband substances near Thingkangphai Petrol Pump along Tedim Road, Churachandpur. Upon receipt of the information, a police team from CCP-PS was immediately formed under the supervision of the OC, CCP-PS, and after making the relevant GD entry, proceeded from the Police Station for interception of the suspected contraband consignment.

On reaching near Thingkangphai Petrol Pump, vigil was maintained in the area. At about 5:30 PM, one white-coloured Bolero vehicle bearing Registration No. MZ-04A-0446 was noticed near the petrol pump. The vehicle halted near the pump for a brief period and the driver was found behaving in a suspicious manner. The police team approached the vehicle and on enquiry, the driver identified himself as Mr. Thenkhomang Khongsai, aged about 36 years, S/o Jangkholun Khongsai of Tuidam Village, Sangaikot Sub-Division, Churachandpur District. During preliminary enquiry, he admitted that he was carrying Opium for delivery at Thingkangphai Village.

As the spot was not conducive and secure for conducting a detailed search and seizure, the vehicle along with the accused person was brought to CCP-PS for conducting search in accordance with law. Requisition was made to the DM, Churachandpur for deputation of an Executive Magistrate at CCP-PS for the search.

Upon the arrival of the Executive Magistrate, namely Mr. Lianminthang Samte, SDC/CCP, search of the Bolero vehicle was conducted at CCP-PS. During the search, 27 (twenty-seven) packets containing suspected Opium concealed inside two nylon sacks (white and yellow in colour) were recovered from the rear portion of the vehicle. The packets were weighed and marked individually as follows:

Accordingly, the recovered 27 packets of suspected Opium weighing approximately 28.940 Kg along with the Bolero vehicle bearing Registration No. MZ-04A-0446 were seized under proper seizure memo in the presence of witnesses and the Executive Magistrate at CCP-PS at about 6:20 PM. Thereafter, the accused person was formally arrested at about 7:00 PM. The accused person and his wife were informed of the grounds of arrest and other legal rights and guidelines as prescribed under law.

Thereafter, the accused person along with the seized items were handed over to you for taking up further necessary legal action.
