Sir,

In compliance with the order of the Commandant, 1st IRB, two teams consisting of 8+2 personnel under the command of Subedar G. Ginkhanlal of 1st IRB, Headquarters Veng, were conducting area sensitization and frisking/checking at Bualian Village on 25/05/2026 from 7:30 AM till 4:30 PM in connection with the visit of the DGP to the district.

While conducting frisking/checking in front of Bualian Petrol Pump, one Honda Activa coming towards Churachandpur town was intercepted and checked at 9:30 am. The rider identified himself as Mr. Pauthansang, aged about 32 years, s/o Late Paukholian of College Veng, Churachandpur. During checking, it was found that he was carrying 10 brown packets inside a carry bag kept in the front space of the Honda Activa. On inquiry, he admitted that he was carrying contraband substances, i.e., WY tablets, from Suangdai for delivery at Churachandpur. As the spot was not conducive and safe for conducting proper frisking/checking and seizure formalities due to security concerns, the suspected WY tablets, the vehicle, and the accused person were brought to CCP-PS for further necessary action.

At CCP-PS, a requisition was made for deputation of an Executive Magistrate. Accordingly, as directed, we proceeded before the Executive Magistrate at the SDO Office, Churachandpur, where one of the packets was opened in the presence of Mr. Lianminthang Samte, SDC, Churachandpur. On opening one brown packet, 5 bundles wrapped in white tissue paper were found inside. Each bundle contained 10 black packets, and each black packet contained 200 tablets suspected to be WY tablets. The accused person was also questioned before the Executive Magistrate, and he admitted that the contraband substances were WY tablets. All the 10 brown packets were weighed individually and marked as A1 to A10, as detailed below:

A1 – 1012 grams, A2 – 1214 grams, A3 – 1198 grams, A4 – 1190 grams, A5 – 1198 grams, A6 – 1202 grams, A7 – 1200 grams, A8 – 1198 grams, A9 – 1191 grams, A10 – 1191 grams
Altogether, the weight of the suspected WY tablets was found to be 11,794 grams (11 kg 794 grams), including the weight of the brown paper cover. The contraband substances, i.e., WY tablets, the vehicle, and the mobile phone of
