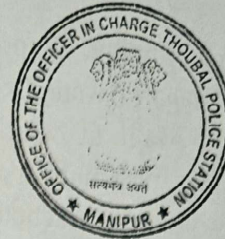

Subject: Registration of FIR regarding suspected cheating and fraudulent activities.

Sir,

I have the honour to report that on 12/05/2026 at 6:30 pm, reliable information was received that five non-local individuals were moving around within the jurisdiction of Thoubal Police Station for the purpose of selling tarpaulin houses and solar-based CCTV cameras to local residents.

Acting on the information, teams of Cammando Unit, Thoubal led by Inspt. K. Nitaranjan Singh, OC, CDO/Thoubal under the supervision of Shri. H. Devendra Singh, MPS, ASP(Ops)/TBL and under the overall supervision of Shri. Manoj Prabhakar M, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Thoubal have conducted frisking and checking at Waithou Naka point area. In that, one Bolero vehicle white in colour bearing registration No. MN06LZ-0569 was seen coming from Lilong side towards Thoubal side in a suspicious manner. The vehicle was stopped and in that five non-local individuals was found inside the vehicle and it was driven by one local person.

On their suspicious nature, they were detained for verification. On preliminarily verification, the non-local individuals were identified themselves as (1) **Firdosh Rizvi (42) yrs S/o Bari Rizvi of Nangla Hareru, Mawana, Meerut, Uttar Pradesh,** (2) **Shahzad (43) yrs S/o Bundu of Ruhaşa Village, Sardana, Meerut, Uttar Pradesh,** (3) **Mohd. Irshad (32) yrs S/o Ishrad Ali of Kajba Khatoli, Mujafarnagar, Uttar Pradesh,** (4) **Shoaib Malik (29) yrs S/o Mobin Malik of Zakir Colony, Hapur Road, Meerut, Uttar Pradesh and** (5) **Mohd. Shan (27) yrs S/o Md. Wasim of Nangla Hareru, Mawana, Meerut, Uttar Pradesh.** The driver was identified himself as **Aris Sheikh (25) yrs S/o Ajijur Rahaman of Hatta Golapati Mayai Leikai, Imphal East** and he disclosed that his vehicle was being on a rental basis by the non-local persons.

On further verification, their (non-local) activities appeared suspicious, and it was suspected that they were dishonestly inducing innocent local people to purchase the above mentioned items by making false representations and promises, thereby cheating the public. Hence, the above five non-locals were arrested at 8:50 pm, 8:55 pm, 9:00 pm, 9:05 pm & 9:10 pm of 12/05/2026 from Waithou Naka Point. They further disclosed that the said items were kept at a rental house located at Hatta Golapati Awang Leikai, Imphal East. However, the driver and vehicle Bolero was released after proper verification.

Accordingly, the police teams along with the detainee rushed to the said place (Hatta Golapati Awang Leikai, Imphal East). At the instance of Shoaib Malik (29) yrs S/o Mobin Malik of Zakir Colony, Hapur Road, Meerut, Uttar Pradesh, the following items (1) 5 (five) numbers of AI Solar Camera + Lighting 2 in 1, (2) 5 (five) numbers of white colour Parachute Tent and (3) 14 (fourteen) numbers of tarpaulin were recovered and the same were seized on the same day at 10:35 pm of 12/05/2026. The whole process of the search and seizure was videographed.

During preliminary inquiry, they stated that they had sold tarpaulin houses and solar-based CCTV cameras at different parts of Manipur. However, they failed to produce any valid documents relating to the ownership, authorization, purchase, lawful possession, or source of the CCTV cameras sold by them.

As there reasonable grounds to suspect the commission of cognizable offences relating to cheating and fraud, it is requested to register a regular FIR under the appropriate provisions of law and take up investigation accordingly.

The arrested persons mentioned above along with the seized article are being handed over to you for taking further necessary action against them.
