Madam,

I have the honour to report that today, i.e., on 15/05/2026, at about 5:30 PM, a reliable information was received from 43 AR regarding transportation of contraband items along the Indo-Myanmar Sugnu Road through NH-137A, Imphal Mayai Lambi route.

Acting upon the said information, a team of CDO Unit, Kakching immediately proceeded and conducted random frisking and checking at NH-137A near Pole Star College under Hiyanglam Police Station. During the checking operation, one Alto K10 vehicle, silky silver in colour, bearing Registration No. MN06LA-6861, coming from Wabagai side and proceeding towards Sekmaiijin side, was noticed and detained for verification.

On verification, the driver of the vehicle was identified as Md. Salim (31) years, S/o Late Md. Halim of Kairang Mayai Leikai, Kairang Muslim, Imphal East District, and the occupant was identified as Md. Nawab (32) years, S/o Md. Rahaman of Kairang Mayai Leikai, Kairang Muslim, Imphal East District.

The behaviour and movements of both individuals appeared highly suspicious and evasive, which led to their detailed interrogation at the spot.

Thereafter, both the individuals were informed that they were suspected to be carrying contraband substances and were apprised of their legal right to have their body and belongings searched either in the presence of a Magistrate or a Gazetted Officer. Upon exercising their option for search before a Gazetted Officer, Smt. Khundrakpam Hemabati, MPS, SDPO/Kakching was immediately informed and she arrived at the spot accordingly.

Subsequently, the vehicle was thoroughly examined in the presence of the Gazetted Officer and during the examination, a specially designed concealed chamber was detected inside the rear bumper portion of the vehicle. Upon opening and checking the concealed chamber, 13 (thirteen) soap cases of different colours containing suspected Heroin No. 4 were recovered. The recovered contraband substances were weighed on the spot using an SF-400A Electronic Compact Scale brought by the police team and the total weight was found to be approximately 147 grams excluding the weight of the soap cases.

Accordingly, the recovered contraband items, namely 13 (thirteen) soap cases containing suspected Heroin No. 4 along with the Alto K10 vehicle silky silver in colour bearing Registration No. MN06LA-6861 along with key and RC were formally seized from the possession of Md. Salim (31) years, S/o Late Md. Halim of Kairang Mayai Leikai, Kairang Muslim, Imphal East District at about 07:16 PM by observing all necessary legal formalities in the presence of witnesses and the Gazetted Officer. During personal search of the accused Md. Nawab (32) years, S/o Md. Rahaman of Kairang Mayai Leikai, Kairang Muslim, Imphal East District, 1 (one) wallet black in colour and a sum of Rs. 52,000/- (Rupees fifty-two thousand) only, suspected to be connected with the illegal transaction, were also recovered and seized by observing due formalities at about 07:26 PM.

Thereafter, both the accused persons were formally arrested from the spot at about 08:30 PM and 08:35 PM respectively after observing all legal formalities and videography of the entire process was conducted at the spot.

Further, upon arrival of the Magistrate namely Yengkhom Jivan Singh ,SDC, Sugnu and FSL team, the seized contraband substances were properly packed, sampled and sealed in their presence at about 09:27 PM by observing all prescribed legal procedures.

Hence, the arrested accused persons along with the seized articles were handed over to OC/Hiyanglam Police Station for taking up further necessary legal action under the relevant provisions of law.
