With due respect, I have the honour to report that on 29/04/2026 at about 3:30 p.m., based on credible intelligence received from a reliable source regarding the transportation of fuel (suspected petroleum/diesel) without a valid permit from Pallel towards Moreh, a naka/check post was alerted.

Accordingly, at about 4:30 p.m., a checking operation was conducted at the CDO Post, Pallel-Chandel Road, in front of Pioneer School, under the command of Sub. S. Birla Singh, OC CDO/KCG, under the supervision of Shri Amarjit Singh Lamabam, MPS, Addl. SP (Ops), and under the overall supervision of Smt. Priyadarshini Laishram, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Kakching. The operation continued until 03:00 pm of 30/04/2026.

During the checking, the following vehicles were detained. Upon inspection, it was found that the vehicles were carrying a large quantity of suspected petroleum/diesel stored in plastic containers/drums without proper safety measures and without producing any valid permit, licence, transit documents, or authorization for transporting such hazardous and inflammable substances. The details of the vehicles and drivers are as follows:

1. One Tata Magic bearing registration No. MN04C-0331, driven by Elvis Lamkang (23 years), S/o Saimon Lamkang of New Lamkang Khunthak, Chandel District, transporting 10 (ten) plastic containers containing approximately 2,200 litres of partially filled diesel.
2. One Eeco Van bearing registration No. MN06LB-4842, driven by Md. Abas Khan (47 years), S/o (L) Md. Isuf of Sangaiyumpham Part-II, Thoubal District, transporting 6 (six) plastic containers containing approximately 1,320 litres of partially filled diesel products.
3. One Eeco Van bearing registration No. MN06LX-2155, driven by Dangsawa Koshil Pipachum (56 years), S/o (L) Dangsawa Modar Pipachim of Nungourok, Chandel District, transporting 5 (five) plastic containers containing approximately 1,100 litres of partially filled diesel.
4. One Eeco Van bearing registration No. MN06LX-1933, driven by Mujibur Rahaman (35 years), S/o (L) Usanai Ali of Sora Makha Leikai, Kakching District, transporting 4 (four) plastic containers containing approximately 880 litres of partially filled petrol products.

On preliminary enquiry, the drivers disclosed that they were transporting the fuel via the Thamnepokpi route towards Tegnoupal Main Road, with the intention of delivering it to Moreh (Myanmar) for illegal commercial purposes.

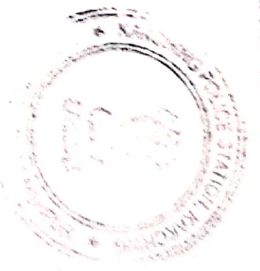
