12. First Information contents:

It is to report that on 19/04/2026 at about 1900 hrs, a torch Rally was organized by members of AMSU in Kakching District Headquarters area in connection with public protest relating to the recent killing of two minor children, Tronglaobi incident. The rally comprising approximately 700-800 persons attempted to proceed towards the District Headquarters complex area. It is pertinent to mention that curfew was already in force in the area vide District Magistrate, Kakching order No. Cril. Misc. case No. 12 of 2026 dated 18/04/2026 and the assembly of such gathering was in violation of the prohibitory orders.

On being restrained by the police personnel deployed at Kakching Bazar area and advised to follow the designated route and disperse peacefully, the crowd became aggressive and unruly, and started confronting the police personnel on duty. The mob, acting as an unlawful assembly, used criminal force against the police, attempted to break through barricades, and advanced towards the restricted zone leading to office of the DC-Kakching.

Thereafter, the situation escalated as the mob turned violent and began pelting stones towards the police personnel and government vehicles, resulting in damage to police vehicles and creating a serious threat to public order and safety. The police personnel on duty exercised minimum necessary force including the use of tear smoke shells and other crowd control measures in order to disperse the violent assembly and restore law and order. After the unruly mob reached near the proximity, the police teams (including Addl. SP(L/O), Kakching, Addl. SP(OPs), Kakching, SDPO-Kakching, OC/CDO-Kakching and OC-Kakching PS, BSF team, RAF team and other mobile teams led by Smt. Priyadarshini Laishram, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Kakching) announced using loudspeaker and asked the mob to disperse from the spot peacefully. But the mob paid no attention and constantly shouted and raised various slogans against the police on duty. The mob became more violent and started pelting more stones towards the police teams on duty from various directions and they also used catapults. The police teams made further announcements to disperse but the mob became more violent. As the situation became more violent, the police teams had no option but to disperse the mob by firing tear shells/mock bombs with the authorization of the Executive Magistrate present.

The acts of the mob clearly disclose commission of cognizable offences including unlawful assembly, rioting, obstruction of public servants in discharge of duty, use of criminal force, and causing damage to government property, in violation of lawful orders and curfew restrictions.

In view of the above facts and circumstances, a suo-mottu case under FIR No. 31(04)2026 KCG-PS U/S 189/191(2)/195/223/324(3)/324(4)/326(e)/351(2) & 3(5) BNS and section 3 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984 has been registered for investigation.
