Subject: Report.

Sir,

I have the honour to state that, today i.e., 03/04/2026 at about 4.30 pm, when I was at NAB-PS, Manipur one of my source man informed me that, one person namely Samaj of Nagamapal is going to deliver a huge quantity of cough syrup containing codeine phosphate in a Hyundai I20 Asta Car white in colour bearing No. MN01AK 6648 at Lamphel Super Market area. The said information was reduced in writing and placed before the Superintendent of Police/NAB, Manipur. Then, I along with a team of NAB-PS, Manipur and all the necessary equipment were constituted for execution of the secret information.

A team of NAB-PS, Manipur assisted by a team of IW District Police moved towards Lamphel Super Market area of Imphal West District, Manipur looking for the same car in the departmental vehicle Maruti Gypsy bearing No. MN01G 0361 along with necessary equipment and documents. On reaching the same spot the combined police team started looking for the Hyundai I20 car. While the police team approaching towards the western side of Lamphel Super Market, IW District, Manipur **one Maruti Alto Car golden colour bearing Regd. No. MN06LX 5757** was found parked at the road side. On the suspicious manner of the driver the combined police team detained the driver and the Maruti Alto Car after identifying ourselves as the police team of NAB-PS and IW District. On looking the car the combined police team saw two white plastic gunny bags inside the dicky. On asking the driver, he informed that the gunny bags inside the dicky are cough syrup containing codeine phosphate. Further, he told the combine police team that, the same cough syrup was delivered by one person namely Samaj of Nagamapal on his Hyundai I20 Car. Accordingly, the driver contacted Samaj through his mobile phone for locating his whereabouts and learnt that he was at one Car Wash near the western side gate of Khuman Lampak Main Stadium. The combine police team immediately rushed towards the said spot and found the **Hyundai I20 Asta Car bearing No. MN01AK 6648** along with the driver and detained at the spot after identifying ourselves as the police team of NAB-PS and IW District. As it is almost to be night and dark and inconvenient for the combined police team to conduct legal procedures. The combined police team brought the two detainee and the two car at a convenient location i.e Near the gate of TG Hr. Sec. School, Old Lambulane, IW District, Manipur.

I requested nearby civilian to witness the search, seizure and arrest procedure but no civilians were found at the spot as it was night time and all the School and College were closed. So, one personnel from the IW District Police namely Hav. 15007366 I. Rojit Singh 43 yrs s/o (L) I. Modhuchandra Singh of Narankonjil Makha Leikai, IW District, Manipur and one personnel from my team namely C/No. 093088 M. Dinesh Singh 45 yrs s/o (L) M. Jagada Singh of Nongpokingol Pureilomba Leikai, Imphal East, Manipur. At the meantime, a requisition was submitted to Scientific Officer, Mobile Forensic Unit, Lamphel, Imphal West for deputing a team of Mobile Forensic Unit. As requisite, the team of MFU, IW District led by Ningombam Sashibala Devi, Scientific Assistant were reached at the spot.



In presence of the witness, the detainee were identified themselves as 1) **Tourangbam Barun Singh 28 yrs s/o (L) T. Sashikumar of Uripok Tourangbam Leikai, IW District, Manipur** and 2) **Samaj Ashangbam 28 yrs s/o A. Samarendra Singh of Near Nityainanda Temple, Nagamapal, RIMS road, IW District, Manipur**. Further, I briefed about the provisions of section 50 NDPS Act, 1985 in Manipuri language to the detainee and were informed that he has legal right u/s 50 NDPS Act to be searched before Magistrate/Gazetted Officer or Civil/Independent Witnesses, if he so desire. A notice u/s 50 NDPS Act was also served to them in which they opted to be searched before civil witnesses.

Further, in presence of the witness, the team of MFU, IW District, Manipur started conducting legal procedures. The MFU, IW District, Manipur marked the **Maruti Alto Car golden colour bearing Regd. No. MN06LX 5757 as 'V1' and Hyundai I20 Asta Car bearing No. MN01AK 6648 as 'V2'**. On opening the panel assy back door of the car marked 'V1' i.e the Maruti Alto Car golden colour bearing Regd. No. MN06LX 5757 found 2 (two) gunny bags white in colour inside the dicky. The 2 (two) gunny bags were marked as 'A' and 'B' for identification. On cutting and opening the gunny bag marked 'A', 2 (two) white gunny bag white in colour were found and marked 'A1' and 'A2', on further opening 'A1' and 'A2', each contained carton box which were again marked the same as 'A1' and 'A2' for identification. On cutting and opening the gunny bag marked 'B', 1 (one) carton box was found and marked the same 'B'.

On opening the 3 (three) carton boxes marked 'A1', 'A2' and 'B', each carton box contained 8 (eight) bundles of Bescodex Cough syrup containing codeine phosphate. On counting, each bundle contained 20 bottles i.e each carton box contained 8 bundles x 20 bottles = 160 bottles {altogether 160 bottles x 3 carton box = 480 bottles (100 ml)}. The team of MFU, IW District randomly took out 1 (one) bottle each from the three carton box marked 'A1', 'A2' and 'B' for field testing using by field testing kits brought by them and gave positive response of codeine phosphate. The remaining bottles after removing the samples were put in their respective carton boxes marked as A1', 'A2' and 'B' i.e 159 bottles each of Bescodex Cough syrup containing codeine phosphate. (total 159 x 3 = 477 bottles (100 ml)). The carton boxes marked A1' and 'A2' containing 159 bottles each (159 x 2 = 318 bottles) were put in a white gunny bag which is properly bind and sealed with wax and marked the same 'A' as parent exhibit. The carton box marked 'B' containing 159 bottles was but in a slightly transparent gunny bag which is properly bind and sealed with wax and marked the same 'B' as parent exhibit. The packing materials i.e the three gunny bags were also bind.

In presence of the witnesses, 1) one white gunny bag which is properly bind and sealed with wax and marked 'A' as parent exhibit containing two carton boxes 'A1' and 'A2' containing 159 bottles each (159 x 2 = 318 bottles) of Bescodex Cough Syrup containing codeine phosphate, 2) one slightly transparent gunny bag which is properly bind and sealed with wax and marked 'B' as parent exhibit containing one carton box marked 'B' containing 159 bottles of Bescodex Cough Syrup containing codeine phosphate, 3) one Maruti Alto car golden in colour bearing Regd. No. MN06L 5757 along with the redg. Smart card and the key, one mobile phone Samsung 22+ beaing mobile No. 6909615538 were seized from the possession of **Tourangbam Barun Singh 28 yrs s/o (L) T. Sashikumar of Uripok Tourangbam Leikai, IW District, Manipur** at the spot on the same day at 8.00 pm by preparing a weighing and seizure memo.

Further, 1) one Hyundai I20 Asta car white in colour bearing regd. No. MN01AK 6648 along with the Regd. Smart Card and the key and one mobile phone I Phone 16 bearing mobile

No. 9862514691 were seized from the possession of Samaj Ashangbam 28 yrs s/o A. Samarendra Singh of Near Nityainanda Temple, Nagamapal, RIMS road, IW District, Manipur at the spot on the same day at 8.05 pm by preparing a seizure memo.

Accordingly, 1) Tourangbam Barun Singh 28 yrs s/o (L) T. Sashikumar of Uripok Tourangbam Leikai, IW District, Manipur and Samaj Ashangbam 28 yrs s/o A. Samarendra Singh of Near Nityainanda Temple, Nagamapal, RIMS road, IW District, Manipur were arrested at 8.10 pm and 8.15 pm respectively by preparing arrest memos. The whole process of search and seizure was videographed. I took the signatures of the arrested accused persons and witness in the parent exhibits marked, weighing and seizure memo, seizure memo and arrest memos and I also put my signatures on the same.

Hence, the arrested accused persons along with the seized items are handed over to you for taking necessary actions.


