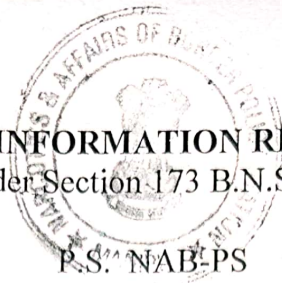

Subject: Report.

Sir,

I have the honour to state that, today i.e., 15/04/20206 at about 10.00 am, when I was at NAB-PS, Manipur one of my source man informed me that, one person namely Micheal Abonmei from Tamenglong is going to transport a huge quantity of opium in an around the area of Sekmai Nongthonban near Indane Bottling Plant, IW District, Manipur. The said information was reduced in writing and placed before the Superintendent of Police/NAB, Manipur. Then, I along with a team of NAB-PS, Manipur and all the necessary equipments was constituted for execution of the secret information.

The detailed team moved towards Sekmai Nongthonban near Indane Bottling Plant, IW District, Manipur in the departmental vehicle bearing No. MN01G 0361 along with necessary equipment and documents. On reaching the spot, the police team of NAB-PS, Manipur take position for looking the suspected person. After a while, one person carrying a bag black in colour was seen moving towards NH-2 Imphal – Dimapur road from Sekmai Indane Bottling Plant. On his suspicious manner, the police team detained him at the road side of Sekmai Nongthonban near Indane Bottling Plant, IW District, Manipur after indentifying ourselves as police officer and personnel of NAB-PS, Manipur. On asking he informed the police team that, he is carrying 2 (two) kg of opium inside the bag black in colour labelled "Carrot". Due to the prevailing law and order situation in the State, conducting legal procedures may disturbed by mob. For the security of the detainee and the police team, the detained person and the detected drug was brought to Sekmai-PS, IW District, Manipur for conducting legal procedures.

On reaching Sekmai-PS, IW District, Manipur, I requested civilians outside the Police Station to witness the search, seizure and arrest procedure. Accordingly, two civilians namely **Md. Mangi 19 yrs s/o Md. Kiramuddin of Yairipok Tulihal Toubokpi Mayai Leikai, IE District, Manipur and Thingujam Herojit Singh 25 yrs s/o Th. Munal Singh of khurkhul Makha Lekai, IW District, Manipur** agreed to witness the same. In presence of the witnesses, the detainee identified himself as **Micheal Abonmei 29 yrs s/o AB Jinkinlakbou of Aling Khundong, Khunkhaiba, Tamenglong, Manipur.**

At the meantime, a requisition was submitted to Scientific Officer, Mobile Forensic Unit, Lamphel, Imphal West for deputing a team of Mobile Forensic Unit. As requisite, a team of Mobile Forensic Unit, Imphal West was arrived at the spot to assist the police team. I briefed about the provisions of section 50 NDPS Act, 1985 in Manipuri language to the detainee and was informed that he has legal right under section 50 NDPS Act to be searched before Magistrate/Gazetted Officer or Civil/Independent Witnesses, if he so desire. A notice u/s 50 NDPS Act was also served to him in which he told that, he opted to be searched before civil witnesses.

Further, in presence of the witnesses, the team of MFU, Imphal West and the police team, started search procedure at the premises of Sekmai Police Station, IW District, Manipur. The bag black in colour labelled "Carrot" was marked "A" for identification and on opening, 2 (two) polythene packets labelled as Ruchi Gold and transparent polythene packets of suspected opium were found in double black polythene packets. Further, the polythene packets marked as Ruchi Gold and transparent polythene packet of suspected opium were marked as "A1" and "A2" for identification. On testing by using the testing kits brought by MFU, IW District, Manipur by cutting the packets and taking out a pinch of suspected opium, the same gave positive result of opium. On weighing, the packets marked "A1" weighed 1.050 kg and "A2" weighed 0.989 kg (in total 2.039 kg) including the weighed of the plastic packets.

The 2 (two) polythene packets labelled as Ruchi Gold which was marked as "A1" and transparent polythene packet marked as "A2" weighing 1.050 kg and 0.989 kgs of opium respectively (in total 2.039 kg) were put in a white gunny bag marked as "B" which was properly packed and sealed with wax.

In presence of the witnesses, one gunny bag marked as "B" containing two packets of opium marked as "A1" and "A2" weighing 1.050 kg and 0.989 kgs of opium respectively (in total 2.039 kg) and one bag black in colour labelled "Carrot" marked "A" along with two black polythene packets were seized from the possession of Micheal Abonmei 29 yrs s/o AB Jinkinlakhbou of Aling Khundong, Khunkhaiba, Tamenglong, Manipur at the spot on the same day at 01.50 pm by preparing a weighing and seizure memo.

Further, one Redmi 13C 5G black in colour bearing No. 9233231025 was also seized on production by Micheal Abonmei 29 yrs s/o AB Jinkinlakhbou of Aling Khundong, Khunkhaiba, Tamenglong, Manipur at the spot on the same day at 01.55 pm by preparing a seizure memo. Accordingly, he was arrested at the spot on the same day at 2.00 pm. The whole process of search, seizure and arrest was video graphed in my eSakshya account. I took the signatures of the arrested accused person and witnesses in the parent exhibit, weighing and seizure memo, seizure memo and arrest memo and I also put my signatures on the same.

Hence, the arrested accused persons along with the seized items are handed over to you for taking necessary actions.


