11. First Information contents:

Brief of the case:

Today, i.e., 29/05/2026, a combined security forces comprising of Manipur Police, CRPF, CRPF (Mahila), BSF and RAF was escorting a convoy of stranded FCI trucks and LPG/IOCL tankers from Yaingangpokpi towards Ukhrul along NH-202.

At about 09:00 AM, upon reaching Shangkai village, villagers of Shangkai and Kuki volunteers including womenfolk's numbering around 150 blocked the highway by placing heavy stones and burning vehicle tyres, bringing the convoy to a complete standstill. Despite repeated verbal warnings to clear the road, the aggressive mob refused to disperse. To control the escalating situation and restore order, security forces were compelled to deploy tear gas shells to safely disperse the crowd. The highway was subsequently cleared and normal traffic was restored.

Since the deliberate blockade and resistance to lawful authority constitute distinct criminal offenses executed with common intention, a regular case under **FIR No. 34(05)2026/LTN-PS, U/S 132/189(5)/191(2)/221/3(5) BNS** has been registered *Suo Motu* by the undersigned for a thorough investigation.
