Subject: Complaint regarding Mob Attack, Vandalism, Arson and Damage to Government Vehicle at Shonglong Part-II/ Waphong Area

Respected Sir,

I, No. G/193600 Rank Warrant Officer (GD) Name Jagdish Singh of Echo Company, 19 Assam Rifles, presently deployed in Kangpokpi District, Manipur, respectfully submit this complaint requesting registration of an FIR regarding an incident of mob violence that occurred on 11 March 2026 at general area Shonglong Part-II / Waphong.

2. On 10 March 2026, I was part of the Night Area Domination Patrol (ADP) deployed at Shonglong Part-II Village. Following a firing incident during the night, follow-up search operations were carried out in the area on the next day.

3. On 11 March 2026 at approximately 1500 hours, while columns of 19 Assam Rifles were deployed in general area Shonglong Part-II / Waphong during the follow-up search operation, a crowd of approximately 100 persons, including around 80 womenfolk and about 20 village volunteers, gathered at Shonglong Part —II and began agitating against the security forces performing lawful duties.

4. During the course of the agitation, the crowd turned violent. Some members of the mob, including women carrying fire torches, forcibly vandalised and set fire to four civil tents (tarpaulin tent structures) established in the area, resulting in complete destruction of the temporary shelters.

5. Simultaneously, several miscreants within the mob resorted to stone pelting at security force personnel and vehicles. During this incident, the front windshield of Government vehicle TATA 407 bearing Registration No. MN-OIAA-2837 was damaged due to stone pelting.

6. The above acts created a serious law and order situation and amounted to unlawful assembly, rioting, arson, mischief causing damage to Government property and obstruction of security forces while performing official duties.

7. The above acts constitute serious offences punishable under relevant provisions of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, including but not limited to:-

- 7.1 Section 190 — Unlawful Assembly
- 7.2 Section 191 — Rioting
- 7.3 Section 221 — Obstructing a Public Servant in discharge of official duty
- 7.4 Section 324 — Mischief causing damage to property
- 7.5 Section 326 — Mischief by fire or explosive substance (Arson)
- 7.6 Section 351 — Criminal Intimidation.

8. In view of the above facts, I respectfully request that:-

- 8.1 An FIR may kindly be registered immediately against the persons involved in the incident.
- 8.2 A thorough investigation may be conducted into the acts of vandalism, arson and damage to Government property.
- 8.3 Appropriate legal action may be taken against the offenders in accordance with law.

9. I am ready to cooperate fully with the investigation and provide any further information or clarification required.
