Sir,

As per endorsement on the above subject filed by Smt. Laishram Mema Devi, Co-Convenor, Khwairamband Ima Keithel Joint Co-Ordinating Committee for Peace on 18/04/2026 to SP-IW to register case in the matter, conduct necessary investigation and take appropriate legal action for false, defamatory and malicious content circulated on social media platform from a page/account in the name of "MANIPUR DELTA VOICE" under the caption/Operation **"OPERATION: HOLLOW MOTHER"** against her, I have enquired into the matter promptly.

The complainant reported a coordinated social media attack titled **"OPERATION: HOLLOW MOTHER"** appearing on the "MANIPUR DELTA VOICE" Facebook page. The post contained a fabricated "Case File" accompanied by the complainant's photograph and personal mobile number. The primary grievances are:

- **Fabricated Corruption:** False claims that she received government contracts from the Hon'ble Chief Minister for "setting tiles for vendors."
- **Administrative Sabotage:** False claims that she used undue influence to manipulate "Nongma Panba" (monthly market closure) orders and pressured the Imphal Municipal Corporation (IMC).
- **Incitement:** The use of Meiteilon language to characterize her as a "conspirator" against the public interest during the on-going state crisis.

Regarding the complainant awarded for specific contracts for "setting of tiles for vendors", a formal letter from the concerned department vide letter No. CE/PWD/Legal/2026/842 dated 24/04/2026, officially disproves this claim.

Regarding the allegation for giving **influenced in market closure notices** (vide No.4/19/2022-IMC dated 10/3/2026) the Municipal Commissioner, Imphal Municipal Corporation (IMC), clarifies that the cleanliness drive on Nongma Panba was a routine administrative decision following established State Government Policy (Order No. MiscM-601/33/2020-MAHUD-Part(2) dated 21/05/2024) and also establishes that the



claims of personal interference are entirely baseless. Smt. Laishram Mema Devi is nowhere connected either in individual or representative capacity for exerting any personal influence/pressure/ request relating to the drafting or issuance of any order or notice in the aforementioned subject. (**Annexure-II**)

Regarding technical enquiry conducted by the Cyber Crime PS (Ref: RR No. 656/CCPS/2026 and RR No. 103/CCPS/2026) highlights the following obstacles and breakthroughs:

- Identification of Mobile Number: Technical analysis of the malicious post revealed the inclusion of contact number 9612058146. Verification of Subscriber Detail Records (SDR) confirms this number belongs to the complainant herself. This establishes a clear case of doxxing and digital impersonation to lend false legitimacy to the fabricated documents. (**Annexure-III-A**)

- Rejection by Meta Inc.: A formal technical requisition was sent to Meta Inc. (Facebook) to obtain the IP logs and registration particulars of the page "MANIPUR DELTA VOICE" and related handles "Eramdam Manipur" and "Nong Lei." However, Meta Inc. has initially REJECTED the requisition, citing procedural grounds or lack of specific judicial orders. (**Annexure-III-B**)

- Alternative Leads: Despite the rejection by Meta, the successful identification of the complainant's own number within the post serves as primary evidence of identity theft (Section 66C IT Act) and malicious intent by the page administrators.

The inquiry findings from the PWD and IMC conclusively prove that the allegations under "OPERATION: HOLLOW MOTHER" were entirely fabricated with the intent to cause personal harm and public unrest. This constitutes a clear violation of legal provisions regarding defamation and digital misinformation.

The rejection by Meta Inc. necessitates an alternative investigative approach, focusing on the identified subscriber data and potential local perpetrators who utilized the complainant's identity for cyber-squatting and defamation.

It is hereby submitted the above findings to be a register a formal FIR under the relevant sections of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS) and the Information Technology Act.
