Subject : FIR regarding armed attack, destruction of property, criminal intimidation, and assault upon villagers of L. Gamdeiphai Village- Regd.

Sir,

I, Lemthang Pulamte, Chief of L. Gamdeiphai Village, Churachandpur District, Manipur, hereby lodge this FIR regarding a serious incident that occurred in our village.

On 22nd June at about 4:30 PM a group of armed miscreants, suspected to be cadres of the CVDF, unlawfully entered L. Gamdeiphai Village and launched a violent attack upon the villagers. The attackers were dressed in T-Shirts displaying the Zomi flag and had their faces masked, which is commonly associated with the attire used by CVDF members. The incident also occurred within the area claimed to be under their so-called jurisdiction.

During the attack, approximately 7 to 10 houses belonging to villagers were vandalized and destroyed, and several houses were set on fire. Photographs depicting the destruction are annexed herewith as Exhibit-A.

Further, my wife, Mrs. Jampineng Pulamte, was brutally assaulted by the attackers and sustained serious injuries. She is presently undergoing medical treatment in hospital. Copies of the relevant medical reports are annexed as Exhibit-B.

The attackers also openly threatened the villagers, including myself, with death and warned that we would be shot without hesitation if we failed to vacate the entire village immediately.

The aforesaid acts disclose the commission of cognizable offences including unlawful assembly, rioting, mischief by fire, destruction of property, voluntarily causing hurt/grievous hurt, criminal intimidation, trespass, and other offences punishable under the relevant provisions of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

I therefore request your good office to register an FIR, conduct a thorough investigation, identify and apprehend all persons involved, and take appropriate legal action in accordance with law. Necessary protection may also be provided to the villagers of L. Gamdeiphai Village in view of the continuing threats.
