Subject: Report.

Sir,

I have the honour to state that, today i.e., 08/06/2026 at about 09.00 am, when I was at NAB-PS, Manipur one of my source man informed me that, one person namely Nongmaithem Rupu Singh 38 yrs s/o N. Komol Singh of Sapam Mamang Leikai, Thoubal District, Manipur is going to transport a huge quantity of heroin powder in a TATA Tanker Bullet bearing Regd. No. AS01SC 9432 through Imphal Jiribam Road. The said information was reduced in writing and placed before the Superintendent of Police/NAB, Manipur. Then, I along with a team of NAB-PS, Manipur and all the necessary equipments was constituted for execution of the secret information.

The detailed team moved through Imphal Jiribam Road approaching towards New Keithelmanbi, Imphal West District, Manipur in the departmental vehicle bearing No. MN01G 0361 along with necessary equipment and documents. While reaching New Keithelmanbi, the police team of NAB-PS, Manipur take position for looking the TATA Tanker Bullet bearing Regd. No. AS01SC 9432. The police team of NAB-PS, Manipur informed CRPF convoy team which was posted at New Keithelmanbi, Imphal West District about the secret information. Accordingly, the combined team i.e I along with my team and a team of M&N Sector QAT & Range Imphal QAT CRPF and a team of 86 Bn. CRPF, Lamphel started looking for the TATA Tanker Bullet bearing No. AS01SC 9432 and the same was found approaching towards New Keithelmanbi Police Picket, Imphal West District, Manipur. Accordingly, the same TATA Tanker Bullet was stopped and parked in front of New Keithelmanbi Police Picket, Imphal West District, Manipur for verification and checking. After identifying ourselves as the police officer and personnel of NAB-PS, Manipur and CRPF, the team started checking the TATA Tanker Bullet and on checking, the combined team found only one occupant i.e the driver of the TATA Tanker Bullet.

On asking, he informed the combined police team that, he is carrying 5 (five) soap cases containing heroin powder which was kept concealed inside the front dash board of the TATA Tanker Bullet bearing No. AS01SC 9432. Subsequently, I requested nearby civilians to witness the search, seizure and arrest procedures and only one lady namely Khwairakpam Thoi Devi 23 yrs w/o Thangjam Nongan Meitei of New Keithelmanbi, Imphal West District, Manipur. At the same time, one police officer posted at New Keithelmanbi Police Picket, Imphal West District, Manipur namely SI Moirangthem Romen Singh 40 yrs s/o (L) M. Lalmani Singh of Phiwangbam Leikai, Moirang, District- Bishnupur, Manipur voluntarily agreed to witness the same.

At the meantime, a requisition was submitted to Scientific Officer, Mobile Forensic Unit, Lamphel, Imphal West for deputing a team of Mobile Forensic Unit. As requisite, a team of Mobile Forensic Unit, Imphal West was arrived at the spot to assist the combined police team. I briefed about the provisions of section 50 NDPS Act, 1985 in Manipuri language to the detainee and was informed that he has legal right under section 50 NDPS Act to be searched before Magistrate/Gazetted Officer or Civil/Independent Witnesses, if he so desire. A notice u/s 50 NDPS Act was also served to him in which he told that, he opted to be searched before civil witnesses.

Further, in presence of the witnesses, the team of Mobile Forensic Unit, Imphal West District and the combined police team started conducting legal procedure at the spot. On verification, the detainee identified himself as Nongmaithem Rupu Singh 38 yrs s/o N. Komol Singh of Sapam Mamang Leikai, Thoubal District, Manipur. On searching, the detainee took out the 5 (five) soap cases which were wrapped with black tape containing suspected heroin powder inside the front dash board of the TATA Tanker Bullet. Accordingly, the Mobile Forensic Unit, Imphal West District team marked the 5 (five) soap cases which were wrapped with black tape

as "A1", "A2", "A3", "A4", and "A5" for identification. On removing the black tape and on opening the soap cases one by one, each soap case contained one transparent plastic packet containing reddish-white colour substances suspected to be heroin powder and marked the same "A1", "A2", "A3", "A4", and "A5". The Mobile Forensic Unit team took out a pinch of suspected heroin powder from each packet for field testing using the field testing kit brought by them and the test gave positive response of heroin. On weighing, each packet marked "A1", "A2", "A3", "A4", and "A5" weighed 12 grams, 11 grams, 10 grams, 12 grams and 13 grams (altogether 58 grams). The 5 (five) transparent plastic packet containing heroin powder were put in its original container i.e the soap cases and the sorted five black tape used in wrapping the soap cases were put in a white gunny bag which was properly bind with plastic thread and sealed with wax and marked "P" as parent exhibit.

In presence of the witnesses, one gunny bag marked as "P" which is properly bind and sealed with wax containing 5 (five) soap cases containing heroin powder marked as "A1", "A2", "A3", "A4", and "A5" weighed 12 grams, 11 grams, 10 grams, 12 grams and 13 grams (altogether 58 grams) and the sorted five black tape used in wrapping the soap cases were seized from the possession of Nongmaithem Rupu Singh 38 yrs s/o N. Komol Singh of Sapam Mamang Leikai, Thoubal District, Manipur at the spot on the same day at 12.50 pm by preparing a weighing and seizure memo.


Further, 1) one mobile phone Redmi 15 5G bearing phone No. 9863574653 and 9362114283, 2) one aadhar card bearing No. 652592734614, 3) one SBI ATM in the name of Nongmaithem Rupu Singh, 4) one PAN card bearing No. GVHPS4331A, 5) one TATA Tanker Bullet bearing No. AS01SC 9432 along vehicle document and key and 6) one driving license were also seized on production by Nongmaithem Rupu Singh 38 yrs s/o N. Komol Singh of Sapam Mamang Leikai, Thoubal District, Manipur at the spot on the same day at 12.55 pm by preparing a seizure memo. Accordingly, he was arrested at the spot on the same day at 1.00 pm.

The whole process of search, seizure and arrest was video graphed in my eSakshya account. I gave intimation about the arrest of the accused person namely Nongmaithem Rupu Singh 38 yrs s/o N. Komol Singh of Sapam Mamang Leikai, TBL District, Manipur to his brother-in-law namely Shri Tekcham Sanatomba of Tekcham Maning Leikai, Thoubal District, Manipur through mobile phone 6009543076 and intimated the accused person about the ground of his arrest. I took the signatures of the arrested accused person and witnesses in the parent exhibit, weighing and seizure memo, seizure memo and arrest memo and I also put my signatures on the same.


Hence, the arrested accused persons along with the seized items are handed over to you for taking necessary actions.
