SUBJECT: First Information report (FIR) against unknown miscreants regarding criminal intimidation, extortion, threat to life, and severe violation of the arms act by placing live ammunition and a threatening handwritten note inside the Manipur international university campus.

Respected Sir,

I, the undersigned, the Registrar of Manipur International University (MIU), acting under the statutory directions of the Chancellor, Prof. Dr. Harikumar Pallathadka, am filing this urgent criminal complaint to report a direct armed threat to the lives of the University's statutory officers by unknown miscreants.

1. That, yesterday, i.e., 14th May, 2026, at approximately 5:00 PM, the official Caretaker of the University campus reported that 2 unknown persons identified themselves as KCP (Nongdrenkhomba Lup) had entered the University campus and entered the room of the office of the Director and left; after they left he discovered highly alarming items

A. Two (2) rounds of live ammunition (bullets).

B. A handwritten extortion/threat note.

2. That, the items were deliberately left within the premises of the Manipur International University campus (which falls under your esteemed jurisdiction).

The Caretaker immediately informed the office about the situation and on the request of Mr N Amarjit Singh, Director the handwritten note was opened to send a Photo of the note,

3. That, recognizing the extreme gravity of the situation and the necessity for forensic integrity, I asked the University Security to cordon off the specific area. and left completely untouched to ensure that your forensic team can extract fingerprints, DNA, and handwriting samples of the unknown culprits.

4. That, while we cannot ascertain the exact identities of the individuals who physically placed the ammunition at this stage, I must bring to your urgent attention the immediate context of this threat. For the past several weeks, an organized criminal syndicate has been attempting a hostile corporate hijacking of the University. They have hacked the University's domains and attempted to hijack our Bank Accounts.

5. That, this act of armed terrorism and extortion by unknown miscreants attracts the severest non-bailable provisions of the law, specifically:

I. Section 25 & 27 of the Arms Act, 1959: For illegal possession, transport, and use of prohibited ammunition to cause terror.

II. Section 308 of the BNS, 2023: Extortion by putting a person in fear of death or grievous hurt.

III. Section 351(3) of the BNS, 2023: Criminal Intimidation with a threat to cause death.

IV. Section 447 of the IPC / Relevant BNS Section: Criminal Trespass.

Therefore, I request you to kindly take necessary action against the Unknown Miscreants. Thanking you sir for your kind co-operation.
