Subject: - Report.

Sir,



I have the honour to report that today, i.e., 18/06/2026, at about 0400 hrs, reliable information was received through own sources regarding the presence of a cadre of the banned organization KCP (MFL) in the Arong Khunou Mayai Leikai area under Kakching District. Acting upon the said information, combined teams of CDO-KCG comprising K-30, K-76, K-49 and K-35, led by Sub. Ksh. Prakash Singh and a column of 46 AR, under the command of Subedar S. Birla Singh, OC, CDO Unit Kakching, under the supervision of Shri Amarjit Singh Lamabam, MPS, Addl. SP (Ops), Kakching, and the overall supervision of Smt. Priyadarshini Laishram, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Kakching, rushed to the indicated area and conducted a cordon and search operation at a suspected location at Arong Khunou Mayai Leikai.

During the operation, one individual matching the received information was detained from the residence of Late M. Gambir Singh of Arong Khunou Mayai Leikai. On preliminary examination, he identified himself as Moirangthem Tondomba Singh @ Teme (44 years), S/o Late M. Gambir Singh of Arong Khunou Mayai Leikai, Kakching District.

Upon sustained questioning, he disclosed that he joined the proscribed outfit UNLF in the year 2000 and underwent military training at Sajik Tampak under Army No. 1242 of the 19th Batch. He further stated that he was previously arrested by Bishnupur CDO in the year 2003. After being released on bail, he rejoined another unlawful banned organization, KCP (MFL), in the year 2023 through one S/S Commander Jack @ Inao. He further revealed that he was working under the command of S/S Commander Alu, who is presently based in Myanmar.

During interrogation, it was strongly suspected that he was involved in the sale and supply of arms and ammunition for the benefit and financial gain of the said banned organization. He further admitted that he was actively involved in extortion activities targeting local Contractor and businessmen. Based on his disclosure and available evidence, he was arrested on the spot at about 0500 hrs after observing all legal formalities. From his possession, one Redmi 13 5G mobile phone bearing IMEI-1: 868074071259044 and IMEI-2: 868074071259051, along with one JIO SIM card bearing mobile number 7005489054, was recovered and seized at about 0505 hrs after observing all legal formalities. Videography of the seizure proceedings was also conducted at the spot.

During further investigation, he revealed that one of his commanders, namely Wahengbam Inao Singh @ Jack, was also actively involved in such activities for the said organization and might be concealing arms and ammunition. Accordingly, teams of CDO Unit Kakching rushed to the rented house of Wahengbam Inao Singh @ Jack (46 years), S/o Late W. Tomba Singh of Kakching Irum

Mapal, Kakching District, and detained him from his rented house located at Kakching Irummapal. He was subsequently brought to the CDO Complex, Kakching, for verification.

On questioning, he disclosed that he joined KCP (MFL) in the year 2005 under Army No. 303 of the 3rd Batch. He further stated that he presently holds the rank of S/S Commander Sergeant. He was earlier arrested by CDO/Thoubal in the years 2009 and 2011 and by Assam Rifles, Lilong Post, in the year 2012. After being released on bail, he rejoined the said unlawful banned organization, KCP (MFL), in the year 2023. He further admitted that he was actively involved in extortion activities targeting local Contractor and businessmen. It was also strongly suspected that he was involved in the sale and supply of arms and ammunition for the benefit and financial gain of the said banned organization. Based on his disclosure and available evidence, he was arrested at the CDO Complex, Kakching, at 9.30 a.m. hrs after observing all legal formalities. From his possession, one Realme C 35 mobile phone bearing IMEI-1: 861712063068819/33 and IMEI-2: 861712063068801/33, along with one JIO SIM card bearing mobile number 6009672713, was recovered and seized at CDO Complex Kakching after observing all legal formalities at 9.35 a.m. Videography of the seizure proceedings was conducted at the CDO Complex.

On further questioning regarding arms smuggling, he disclosed that one of his associates, namely Nongmaithem Davit Meitei (42) s/o. N. Chaoba Meitei of Loushi ChingKakpham, Kakching District, was involved in concealing arms and ammunition. Accordingly, teams of CDO/KCG rushed to Langathel Mamang Leikai after informing Thoubal Police Control room through Kakching Police Control room and detained the said individual. However, a large number of women gathered at the spot and created a mob situation. Owing to the prevailing law and order situation, the arrest and seizure formalities could not be completed at the spot.

The individual was therefore brought to the Commando Complex for detailed interrogation. During questioning, he admitted that he had sold one 6-round pistol. Based on his disclosure and available evidence, he was arrested at the CDO Complex at 11.50 a.m. after observing all legal formalities. From his possession, one Redmi Note 15 Pro 5G mobile phone bearing IMEI-1: 868495077949587 and IMEI-2: 868495077949595, along with one JIO SIM card bearing mobile number 9366380151, was recovered and seized at 11.55 a.m. Videography of the seizure proceedings was also conducted at the CDO Complex.

On further questioning, he disclosed that one of his associates, namely Maibam Lokendro Singh (38 years), S/o Late M. Bolai Singh of Wabagai Thambal Chingya, Kakching District, was concealing a 6-round pistol. Accordingly as a follow up action, teams of CDO/KCG rushed to his residence and brought him to the CDO Complex for verification.

During interrogation, he disclosed that a 6-round pistol looted from the Kakching Police Station Malkhana had been handed over to him by one Kenedy of Kakching Pung Pareng. He further revealed that he subsequently passed the said firearm to one Boycha. Based on his disclosure and available evidence, he was arrested at the CDO Complex at about 1.15 p.m. after observing all legal formalities. From his possession, one OPPO A31 mobile phone bearing IMEI-1: 864360048915998 and IMEI-2: 864360048915980, along with one JIO SIM card bearing mobile number 9366764150, was recovered and seized at 1.20 p.m. after observing all legal formalities. Videography of the seizure proceedings was also conducted at the CDO Complex, Kakching.

Thereafter, all the arrested persons along with the seized articles were handed over to the Officer-in-Charge, Arong Nongmaikhong Police Station, for registration of a case and further necessary legal action.
