12. First Information Contents. ASI Y. Johny Singh of HNG PS submitted an inquiry report stating that on 16/02/2026 @0830 hrs shared a credible information from Lawful Interception Unit(LIU), Manipur to the Superintendent of Police, Imphal East District, Nodal Officer of Lawful Interception Unit(LIU), Manipur that Sahid Shah S/o Late Ishak Shah of Kairang Mayai Leikai who is a warder of Manipur Central Jail, Sajiwa, I/E is reportedly allowing prisoner's for communication with their respective cadres and money transfer by using the mobile no.8974575763 and 9378070340 which are issued in his name. The first SIM is reportedly being used for communication while the second sim for UPI(money transfer). Further, another landline number 03852910126 is also being reportedly used by the UAP prisoners. Accordingly, directed OC/HNG-PS to conduct an enquiry.

On receipt of the said information an enquiry was conducted. During enquiry Sahid Shah aged about 35 yrs S/o Late Ishak Shah of Kairang Mayai Leikai was examined and it came to learnt that the warder Sahid Shah was responsible for prisoner communication including use of mobile phones. A total four (4) mobile phones were used for inmate communication. These phones and Sim cards were procured in the name of the warder Sahid Shah and one sim card was obtained from an unknown person. The warder Sahid Shah allowed inmates to use his personal UPI(G-pay)number 9378070340 to receive money from inmates' family members.

From the above facts it is clearly established that mobile phones and SIM cards were procured and used within jail premises without proper authorization, verification or monitoring. Call records were not maintained, numbers were not verified and call logs were deleted indicating lack of control and security breach. Personal financial channels (UPI) were used for receiving money from inmate's relative which is irregular and suspicious. The lapse enabled misuse of communication facilities and information indicates such phones were used for extortion. It is therefore enquiry establishes gross negligence, unauthorized facilitation of communication and security breach within jail premises which enabled inmates to use mobile phones for unlawful purposes including extortion.

The involvement and knowledge of responsible jail staff allowing unsupervised calls and failure to maintain monitoring or records constitute serious misconduct and criminal liability.

In view of the above findings, sufficient prima facie evidence exists against warder Sahid Shah for registration of a criminal case. Hence the case.
