Sir,

With due respect, I have the honour to report that on 03/06/2026 at about 11.30 a.m., based on credible intelligence received from a reliable source regarding the transportation of fuel (suspected petroleum/diesel) without a valid permit from Chandel towards Moreh, a naka/check post was alerted.

Accordingly, I along with my team assisted by Sub. Ksh. Prakash Singh (Killo- 30) at about 1200 hrs. a checking operation was conducted at the CDO Post, Pallel-Chandel Road, in front of Pioneer School, under the command of Sub. S. Birla Singh, OC CDO/KCG, under the supervision of Shri Amarjit Singh Lamabam, MPS, Addl. SP (Ops), and under the overall supervision of Smt. Priyadarshini Laishram, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Kakching.

During the checking, the following vehicles were detained. Upon inspection, it was found that the vehicles were carrying a large quantity of suspected petroleum stored in plastic containers/drums without proper safety measures and without producing any valid permit, licence, transit documents, or authorization for transporting such hazardous and inflammable substances. The details of the vehicles and drivers are as follows:

1. One Yodha bearing registration No. MN09B- 0472 driven by Pasel Nepolian Anal 43yrs. S/o (L) Ps. Thumthung Anal of Panchai Village, Chandel District transporting 11(eleven) plastic containers containing approximately 2,420 litres of partially filled petrol.

2. One Ecco Van bearing registration No. MN06LX5931, driven by Lh. Koko George 29yrs. S/o Lh. Robin of Panchai Village, Chandel District, transporting 6 (six) plastic containers containing approximately 1260 litres of partially filled petrol product. In total, 17 (Seventeen) containers amounting to approximately 3680 litres.

On further questioning, the drivers disclosed that they were transporting the fuel towards Tengnoupal Main Road, with the intention of delivering it to Moreh (Myanmar) for illegal commercial purposes. The drivers along with the vehicles and the fuel, have been handed over to your office for taking further necessary legal action.
