

PRESS NOTE
Imphal, the 01st June, 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Shri Mukesh Singh, IPS, assumed charge as the Director General of Police, Manipur, today. Upon his arrival at the Police Headquarters (PHQ), Mantripukhri, he was accorded a Guard of Honour by Manipur Police.

Following the ceremonial reception, the DGP held a brief introductory meeting with senior police officers. He discussed key policing priorities and emphasised the importance of professionalism, upholding the Constitution of India and the Rule of Law, coordination with Sister Agencies, and impartiality and neutrality in the discharge of duties to the public.

Senior officers of Manipur Police were present on the occasion.

- III. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts.
- IV. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
1. On 01.06.2026, security forces arrested 02 (two) extortionists active cadres of RPF/PLA from two different locations, namely:
 - i) Maibam Arun Singh alias Uru (49) of Khurai Ningthoubung Leikai, near Community Hall, Imphal East district from Top Awang Leikai under Porompat-PS, Imphal East district.
 - ii) Thangjam Surankumar Singh alias Achouba alias Rajesh (30) of Pourabi Awang Leikai, Imphal East district from Top Makha Leikai under Porompat-PS, Imphal East district.
 2. On 01.06.2026, Manipur Police arrested an active cadre of KYKL, one Bramacharimayum Sana Sharma alias Ibungo alias Manisana (38) of Mayang Imphal Bazar, Imphal West district, a/p Mayang Imphal Thana Awang Leikai, Imphal west district from the office complex of CDO Imphal West, Minuthong under Imphal-PS, Imphal West district.
- V. On 01.06.2026, security forces arrested 02 (two) persons near CMC Hospital, Koirengei namely:-
 - i) Purna Bahadur Karke (40) of Kanglatongbi Hatik Khuwa (he was serving as VDF in Kangpokpi district) and
 - ii) Lovingson (37) of Kanglatongbi Santipur.From their possession, 1.425 kg of suspected Brown Sugar (including carry bag weight) and 01 (one) Honda Activa were seized.
- VI. On 01.06.2026, Manipur Police apprehended 04 (four) persons from different location within the Imphal City area for selling liquor illegally namely,
 - i. Polem Diamond Singh (30) of Thangmelband Polem Leikai.
 - ii. Moirangthem Dingku Singh (26) of Moirang Sendra.
 - iii. Moirangthem Lalhaiba (33) of Bamon Leikai.
 - iv. Laishram Romesh Singh (43) of Sugnu Napat Mayai Leikai.From their possession, huge amount of illegal liquor were seized.
- VII. Movement of **289** vehicles carrying essential items along NH-37 has been ensured. Strict security measures are taken up in all vulnerable locations and security convoy is provided in sensitive stretches in order to ensure free and safe movement of the vehicles.

- VIII. A total of **114** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.
- IX. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- **9233522822** of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
