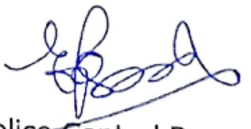


PRESS NOTE
Imphal, the 1st July 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts.
- III. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
 1. On 30.06.2026, security forces arrested an extortionist active cadre of NRFM, one Sairem Bolex Singh alias Pamel (26) of Yurembam Mayai Leikai from Sagoltongba Makha Leikai under Patsoi-PS, Imphal West district.
 2. On 01.07.2026, Manipur Police arrested an extortionist active cadre of PLA who was involved in transportation of arms and ammunition, one Oinam Kalajit alias Yaikhomba Singh (55) of Ngairangbam Mayai Leikai from Toubungkhok area under Patsoi-PS, Imphal West district.
- IV. On 01.07.2026, security forces intercepted a vehicle at Porompat area and arrested two occupants along with contraband items:
 - i) Bigyan Baniya (21) of Tuilangphai, Kangpokpi district, and
 - ii) Manoj Chettry (27) of Kohima, Nagaland.

The intercepted four-wheeler and 168 soap cases of suspected Heroin No. 4 weighing approximately 2 kgs were seized from the duo.
- V. Movement of **531** vehicles carrying essential items along NH-37 has been ensured. Strict security measures are taken up in all vulnerable locations and security convoy is provided in sensitive stretches to ensure free and safe movement of the vehicles.
- VI. A total of **115** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.
- VII. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- **9233522822** of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
