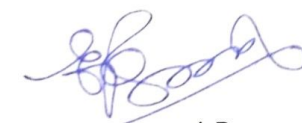
- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Combing Ops to Disengage armed militants & Village Volunteers on 10 June 2026:

In view of recent developments, there were intelligent reports that armed persons were planning to attack isolated villages in hills. Accordingly, a joint operation was launched at Horei Kaphung hills (Lower Leishan Ridge).

During the operation, approximately dozen armed persons were spotted on top of the hills. While some of them fled, eight persons were detained, disarmed and were let off with a stern warning not to venture into hills or carry weapons since it is prohibited. A large quantity of weapons, ammunition and war like stores were recovered from unauthorised bunkers on the hill top.

Security Forces are committed to continue launching operations to safeguard all affected communities and villages.

- III. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts.
- IV. A total of **113** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.
- V. Movement of **846** vehicles carrying essential items along NH-37 has been ensured. Strict security measures are taken up in all vulnerable locations and security convoy is provided in sensitive stretches in order to ensure free and safe movement of the vehicles.
- VI. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- **9233522822** of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
