

PRESS NOTE
Imphal, the 12th June 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts, resulting in recovery of arms and ammunition:
 1. On 11.06.2026, security forces recovered from Helrok Part-II, Mayai Leikai area under Helrok -PS, Thoubal district, inter alia, the following Incriminating articles:
 - i. 01 (one) .32 Pistol with magazine,
 - ii. 02 (two) SBBLS,
 - iii. 71 (seventy one) live rounds ammunition of different calibres,
 - iv. 02 (two) Tear Smoke Shells-SR,
 - v. 12 (twelve) KCP logo stickers,
 - vi. 14 (fourteen) BP plates,
 - vii. 01 (one) BP jacket,
 - viii. Military attires including camouflage shirts, pants, P-Caps, shoes, and belts.
- III. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
 1. On 11.06.2026, security forces arrested 02 (two) active cadres of PLA from different locations:
 - i. Sougaijam Zetison Singh (27) of Kakching Khunyai Leikai A/P Langol near Shija Hospital, arrested from his current locality under Lamphel -PS, Imphal West, and
 - ii. Yengkhom Sarjit Singh @ Monba (21) of Kakching Paji Leikai, Kakching district, arrested from his residence.The following incriminating items were recovered from the house of Sougaijam Zetison Singh of Kakching Khunyai:
 - i) 01 (one) 9mm pistol with empty magazine,
 - ii) 18 (eighteen) live rounds ammunition of different calibres,
 - iii) 01 (one) 12 bore cartridge,
 - iv) 04 (four) detonators,
 - v) 02 (two) remote control devices of IEDs, and
 - vi) 01 (one) PLA flag/banner.
- IV. On 11.06.2026, security forces arrested one Md. Eliyash Khan alias Apik alias Rocky (36) of Kwakta Khuman Ward No. 8, Bishnupur district, A/p – Mantripukhri Friends Colony, Imphal East district from his current locality under Heingang-PS.

A replica of a 9 mm pistol with which he was threatening and intimidating general public was seized from him.
- V. On 12.06.2026, security forces arrested one Md. Farish Khan (28) of Sangaiyumpham Nungphou Mamang Leikai under Thoubal-PS, Thoubal District from his residence along with, inter alia, the following incriminating items:
 - i. 13.4 grams of heroin powder contained in two bottles,
 - ii. A plastic jar containing 17.9 kgs of heroin,
 - iii. Cash amount of Rs. 37,500/-
 - iv. 01 (one) no. of Honda Activa 6G.

- VI. On 12.06.2026, Manipur Police arrested one Dil Bahadur Chetry (41) of Tinsukia, under Chapakhowa-PS, Assam along with 412 grams of WY (Methamphetamine) tablets from North AOC area under Imphal-PS, Imphal West district.
- VII. A total of **116** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.
- VIII. Movement of **627** vehicles carrying essential items along NH-37 has been ensured. Strict security measures are taken up in all vulnerable locations and security convoy is provided in sensitive stretches in order to ensure free and safe movement of the vehicles.
- IX. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- **9233522822** of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
