

PRESS NOTE
Imphal, the 15th June 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
1. On 14.06.2026, security forces arrested a woman active cadre of KCP (Nongdrenkhomba), one Laithangbam (O) Sanatombi Devi (24) of Tabungkhok Makha Leikai, Patsoi-PS, Imphal West District, a/p Langol Game Village, Zone-III, Lamphel- PS, Imphal West district from her current locality.
 2. On 14.06.2026, security forces arrested an active cadre, s/s Private of KCP (MFL), one Yambem Momocha Singh alias Abungcha (34) of Pourabi Makha Leikai, Lamlai- PS, Imphal East district from his residence.
 3. On 14.06.2026, security forces arrested two active cadres of RPF/PLA from their respective residences in Imphal West district:
 - i) Roshan Yumnam (33) of Maklang Makha Leikai, and
 - ii) s/s Sergeant Major Khwairakpam Chetan Meitei (37) alias Nanao alias Chumthang of Thaoroijam Mamang Leikai.
 4. On 14.06.2026, security forces arrested an active cadre of URF, one Md. Nawaj Khan alias Hero (20) of Minuthong Golapati, Imphal East district an extortionist from his residence.
 5. On 14.06.2026, security forces arrested an active cadre of NRFM from Yaripok Lamlai crossing area under Andro-PS, Imphal East district, one Ningthoujam Premkumar Singh alias Punsirol alias Ibungo (35) of Keibul Mayai Leikai under Keibul Lamjao-PS, Bishnupur district.
 6. On 14.06.2026, security forces arrested an active cadre of UNLF (P), one Khumukcham Shyamsunder Singh (54) of Chinga Mathak Nameirakpam Leikai, Singjamei-PS, Imphal West district from his residence.
A 9mm pistol along with magazine was recovered from him.
 7. On 14.06.2026, Manipur Police arrested an extortionist active cadre of RPF/PLA from the Naka Check Point at Ngaikhong Khunou, Bishnupur district, one Moirangthem Naresh Singh alias Thoungamba alias Chingsang (30) of Tuibong Farm Mamang, Churachandpur district, a/p Project Mayai Leikai, Bishnupur district.
A two-wheeler Bajaj Pulsar, (MN01AB-2102) was seized from him.
 8. On 15.06.2026, security forces arrested an active cadre, s/s Private of RPF/PLA, one Thoudam Roshan Meitei alias Pibarel (21) of Sawombung Maniyaiskul under Lamlai-PS, Imphal East district from his residence.
- III. On 14.06.2026, following the arrest of one Meitankeishangbam Jiban Meitei alias Katungcha (43) of Sabungkhok Makha Leikai, Imphal East district from Khatkhathi, Assam earlier and subsequent investigation, security forces recovered from Pangei and Yairipok areas, the following:
- i) 03 (three) INSAS rifles,
 - ii) 01 (one) Ex-Calibre rifle,
 - iii) 02 (two) SLR rifles,
 - iv) 02 (two) .303 rifles,
 - v) 01 (one) 9 mm pistol,
 - vi) 01 (one) 7.65 mm pistol,
 - vii) 33 (thirty-three) ammunition rounds of different calibers,
 - viii) 10 (ten) magazines of different arms.

- IV. On 14.06.2026, security forces detected 240 cans of beer during routine checking at Wangoi-PS Gate, Imphal West district. The same were handed over to Excise Station at Hiyangthang.
- V. On 13.06.2026, Manipur Police arrested one Mr. Thongkhosei Haokip (44) of Molnoi Pallel, Tengnoupal district, a/p Deilhenphai village, Churachandpur after intercepting the Alto car (WB-196-8906) he was driving at Headquarter Veng Churachandpur general area under Churachandpur-PS. Seventy-seven soap cases of suspected brown sugar were recovered from the intercepted car.
- VI. On 14.06.2026, security forces intercepted a four-wheeler Innova (AS-23AK-5541) resembling the official vehicle of a Brigadier, and arrested the driver, one Tarkeshwar Singh (45) of Hijuguri Gaon Tinsukia Margherita, Assam from T. Khullen, Senapati district. Seventeen packets of suspected opium weighing 15.4 kgs were recovered from the intercepted vehicle. The authenticity of the vehicle that has a flag post and other insignia of the military is being investigated into.
- VII. On 13.06.2026, security forces arrested three residents of Churachandpur district along with sixty-seven soap cases containing suspected brown sugar weighing approximately 670 grams from the general area of Tongdam under Churachandpur-PS:
- i) Pauzathang (45) of Singngat village,
 - ii) Ginpu Zou (39) of Thingkangphai village and,
 - iii) Kailunmang (30) of Hiangtam village.
- VIII. Manipur Police continue its drive to curb motor vehicle offences:
- 1. From 08.06.2026 to 14.06.2026, Manipur Police issued **80 (eighty)** challans to motor vehicle offenders, amounting a total of **Rs. 79,500/- (seventy nine thousand five hundred)**.
 - 2. From 07.06.2026 to 13.06.2026, tinted films from **21 (twenty one)** vehicles were removed.
- IX. A total of **116** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.
- X. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- **9233522822** of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
