

PRESS NOTE
Imphal, the 16th June 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. On 15.06.2026, as part of community policing, a Cybercrime and Drug Abuse Awareness Program was conducted at Anita Standard High School, Kwakta, Bishnupur district. Officers of Manipur Police delivered informative lectures on cybercrime, its various forms, preventive measures, and the harmful effects of drug abuse among students and society. The participants were also sensitized about safe internet practices and the importance of staying away from drugs.
A total of 50 students participated in the interactive program during which they actively engaged in a question-and-answer session and sought clarification on various issues related to cybercrime and drug abuse.
The program concluded successfully with positive feedback from the students and school authorities.
- III. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
 1. On 15.06.2026, security forces arrested 02 (two) active cadres of RPF/PLA from different locations of Imphal West district:
 - i) Mutum Mohen Singh (29) of Oinam Mamang Leikai, Bishnupur district, a/p Sagolband Moirang Hanuba Mayai Leirak, arrested from his current locality, and
 - ii) Sanayaima Leichombam alias Quinton alias Leirangjao alias Leirengbi (50) of Leimaram Awang Leikai, Bishnupur district, arrested from Lamphel Sanakeithel area.
- IV. On 16.06.2026, security forces arrested one Yumnam Seityajit Mangang (36) of Khurai Puthiba Leikai, a/p Sambei Kangtak, Imphal East district. A .22 calibre revolver and nine live rounds of .22 ammunition were seized from him.
- V. On 15.06.2026, security forces destroyed twelve bunkers (two bunkers at Shangkai - Mongkot Chepu Villages hill stretch and ten bunkers at Leingangching - Sikibung village hill stretch) under Litan- PS, Ukhrul district. A binocular, twenty-one empty cases of different weapons and eight live rounds of SBBL were also recovered.
- VI. On 16.06.2026, security forces destroyed fourteen bunkers (five bunkers at Mogkot Chepu- Patlijang hill stretch, and nine bunkers along the Lungphu Junction - Industrial Estate center hill stretch). Two empty cases of 5.56 mm were recovered from the former site.
- VII. A FIR case registered at Women- PS, Senapati district under Sections of the POCSO Act, has resulted in conviction.

Three juveniles involved in the case will be detained in Observation Home for 19 days. A fine of Rs. 5,000 each has been imposed upon the juveniles which shall be paid to the parents of the victim. Further, a compensation of Rs. Five lakhs to the victim have been recommended. The CCLs were directed to perform community service for a period of one month.
- VIII. On 16.06.2026, Manipur Police arrested one Maibam Umakanta (27) of Ukhongsang Nongpok Sekmai, a/p Wahengbam Leikai from his current locality for assaulting and stabbing a Traffic Police personnel on duty earlier at Paona Bazaar. The knife with which the police was stabbed has also been recovered.

- IX. On 15.06.2026, Manipur Police arrested 02 (two) persons along with approximately 2.0 kgs of suspected Morphine:
- i. Ms. Hoineilhing (32) of T. Khonomphai Village, arrested from Molnom village Churachandpur district and
 - ii. Chinneivah (25) of T. Khonomphai Village, arrested from her residence.
- X. On 16.06.2026, security forces arrested one RY Ambison (45) of Utonglok, Kangpokpi district from Gamgiphai Naka under Sapermeina –PS. 160 Litres of DIC Liquor and an Auto rickshaw (MN01Z- 1749) were seized from him.
- XI. Movement of **579** vehicles carrying essential items along NH-37 has been ensured. Strict security measures are taken up in all vulnerable locations and security convoy is provided in sensitive stretches in order to ensure free and safe movement of the vehicles.
- XII. A total of **115** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.
- XIII. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- 9233522822 of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
