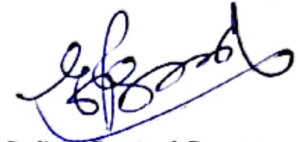


PRESS NOTE
Imphal, the 18th June 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
 1. On 18.06.2026, Manipur Police arrested four active cadres of KCP (PWG), all residents of Imphal East district involved in placing hand grenades at multiple locations within Imphal East district including one at a Brahmapur Nahabam Bamon Leikai residence:
 - i. Huidrom Palinba Singh alias Nanao (19) of Kongba Ucheckon,
 - ii. Pebam Roshan Singh (18) of Singjamei Pebiya Pundit Leikai,
 - iii. Nameirakpam Jitson Meitei (19) of Bashikhong Mamang Leikai, and
 - iv. Maimom Lemba Meitei (28) of Ningomthong Kitnapanung.

A four-wheeler vehicle used by them in extortion-related activities was also recovered from Ayangpali area.
 2. On 18.06.2026, security forces arrested four active cadres of KCP (MFL), all residents of Kakching district who were involved in extortion and illegal supply of arms from different locations within Kakching district:
 - i. Moirangthem Tondomba Singh alias Teme (44) of Arong Khunou Mayai Leikai, arrested from Arong Nongmaikhong,
 - ii. Wahengbam Inao Singh alias Jack (46) of Kakching Irum Mapal, arrested from his locality,
 - iii. Nongmaithem David Meitei (42) of Loushi ChingKakpham, arrested from Langathel, and
 - iv. Maibam Lokendro Singh (38) of Wabagai Thambal Chingya, arrested from his locality.
 3. On 16.06.2026, security forces arrested an active cadre of RPF/PLA, one Arambam Sanayaima Meitei alias Ali (48) of Nongdam Mayai Leikai, Imphal East district from Kangla Sangomshang Awang Leikai under Lamlai-PS, Imphal East district.
 4. On 17.06.2026, security forces arrested an active cadre of KCP (PWG), one Hemam Laingam Meitei alias Ngamba (33) of Moirang Khoiru Mayai Leirak, Bishnupur district from his locality under Moirang-PS.
- III. On 18.06.2026, security forces rescued from Gate No. 1 area under Moreh-PS, Tengnoupal district, one Ngamsom Baite (50) of B. Bongjang Village, Moreh who was allegedly abducted from his village by suspected PSH cadres.
The rescued person has since been handed over to his family members.
- IV. Movement of **474** vehicles carrying essential items along NH-37 has been ensured. Strict security measures are taken up in all vulnerable locations and security convoy is provided in sensitive stretches in order to ensure free and safe movement of the vehicles.
- V. A total of **115** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.

- VI. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number-9233522822 of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
