

PRESS NOTE
Imphal, the 19th June 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
1. 10 (ten) accused persons were arrested in NIA cases in joint raids by combined teams of Manipur Police, NIA and CRPF at various districts including but not limited to Churachandpur, Imphal and Ukhrul. The cases include Ukhrul PNB bank robbery case, 5th IRB arms loot case, murder of Jiribam Hmar woman case, abduction and killing of 04 Kukis, attack on CRPF at Narainsena and ambush in the convoy of CM.
 2. On 19.06.2026, Manipur police arrested an active cadre of KCP (PWG) from Maibam Leikai area under Singjamei-PS, Imphal West namely, Surensangbam Bungcha alias Winner (46) of Singjamei Naorem Leikai.
 3. On 18.06.2026, security forces arrested from ISBT Complex area an active cadre of RPF/PLA, one RK Solomon Singh (51) alias Amon of Thangmeiband Lourungpurel Leikai, Imphal West district, and his associate Thangmeishang Kasar (32) of Phange Village, Kamjong district, a/p Nagamapal Khwai Brahmapur Laimayum Leirak, Imphal West.
A juvenile the duo was attempting to recruit as cadre for RPF/PLA was also rescued.
- Further, a s/s Lieutenant Colonel (Director In-Charge of Intelligence) of RPF/PLA, one Sarangthem Jayenta Meetei alias Bicky alias Wanglen (48), of Hiyangthang Maning Awang Leikai, Imphal West district was arrested from Kongba Bazar area, Imphal East.
- Besides other incriminating items, a cash amount of ₹2,000/ and a white Bolero Camper were seized from them.
4. On 18.06.2026, security forces arrested a S/S Captain, active cadre extortionist of KCP (PWG) from his residence, one Wangkhem Premjit Singh alias Kamcha alias Ibomcha (46) of Luker Mayai Leikai, Imphal West district.
 5. On 19.06.2026, security forces arrested a juvenile active cadre of UKNA, from the general area of Songpi village under Churachandpur-PS.
- III. Movement of **515** vehicles carrying essential items along NH-37 has been ensured. Strict security measures are taken up in all vulnerable locations and security convoy is provided in sensitive stretches in order to ensure free and safe movement of the vehicles.
- IV. A total of **118** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.
- V. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- 9233522822 of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
