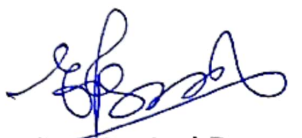


PRESS NOTE
Imphal, the 24th June 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts resulting in recovery of arms and ammunition:
 1. On 24.06.2026, security forces recovered from the general area of Kotlen, Kangpokpi district, inter alia, the following:
 - i. 01 (One) 5.56 mm Ex Caliber Rifle,
 - ii. 08 (Eight) Single Barrel rifles,
 - iii. 04 (Four) Improvised mortars,
 - iv. 01 (One) UBG,
 - v. 05 (Five) Lathods,
 - vi. 236 (Two Hundred Thirty Six) live rounds ammunition of different calibers,
 - vii. 02 (Two) Magazines,
 - viii. 01 (One) Baofeng handset and charger.
- III. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
 1. On 22.06.2026, security forces arrested a s/s Lance Corporal of MNPF (Manipur Naga People Front) from Khuman Lampak near ISBT Gate under Imphal-PS, Imphal West district, one Siro Wungta alias Ronaldo (24) of Tarong Village, Kamjong district.
- IV. A total of **112** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.
- V. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- **9233522822** of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
