

PRESS NOTE  
Imphal, the 28<sup>th</sup> June 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts.
- III. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
  1. On 27.06.2026, security forces arrested 02 (two) extortionists active cadres of KCP (PSC - Politburo Standing Committee) from different locations:
    - i) Koijam Lamyamba Meitei alias Punshiba alias Ningol (23) of Yairipok Malom Mamang Leikai, Thoubal district, arrested from FCI Godown, Sangaiprou, Imphal West district and
    - ii) Lourembam Rojit alias Lamnganba alias Pukhri (19) of Chandrakhong Mayai Leikai, Thoubal district, arrested from Ningel Lamkhai area near Yairipok, Thoubal district.
  2. On 27.06.2026, security forces arrested a s/s Captain of RPF/PLA, one Thokchom Bango Singh alias Ibopishak alias Utomba (44) of Heirok Part-I, Mamang Leikai from Khongjom area under Khongjom-PS, Thoubal district along with, inter alia, the following:
    - i) 01 (one) 9 mm Pistol with magazine,
    - ii) 97 (ninety seven) live rounds ammunition, and
    - iii) 01 (one) Toyota Fortuner without registration number.
  3. On 27.06.2026, related to a FIR registered at Singjamei-PS, Manipur Police took formal arrest of the chairman of KCP (Taibangnganba) after being brought from Tihar jail where he was lodged earlier, one Haobijam Dilip Singh alias Taibangnganba (52) of Keibul Lamjao a/p Bishnupur Mamang Awang Leikai, Bishnupur district.
- IV. On 27.06.2026, Manipur Police seized 540 grams of suspected Heroin brown sugar from a bus (MN01-2217) under Khongjom-PS, Thoubal district.  
Efforts to arrest the driver, one Md. Warish (33) of Nungei Khongban is underway.
- v. Manipur Police continue its drive to curb motor vehicle offences:
  1. From 22.06.2026 to 28.06.2026, Manipur Police issued **64 (sixty four)** challans to motor vehicle offenders, amounting a total of **Rs. 1,37,000/- (one lakh thirty seven thousand only)**.
  2. From 21.06.2026 to 27.06.2026, tinted films from **08 (eight)** vehicles were removed.
- VI. A total of **113** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.

VII. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- **9233522822** of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
