

PRESS NOTE
Imphal, the 29th June 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts resulting in recovery of arms and ammunition:
 1. On 29.06.2026, security forces recovered, inter alia, the following arms, ammunition and war like stores which were kept concealed amongst the biomass Phumdi of Loktak Lake near Phubala Patton area under Moirang-PS, Bishnupur district:
 - i) 01 (one) RPG Launcher,
 - ii) 02 (two) .32 Pistols with a magazine each,
 - iii) 02 (two) Hand grenades,
 - iv) 02 (two) Lathode bombs,
 - v) 02 (two) RPG grenades,
 - vi) 01 (one) Improvised mortar shell,
 - vii) 01 (one) artillery shell,
 - viii) 15 (fifteen) ammunition rounds of different calibers,
 - ix) 01 (one) detonator,
 - x) 01 (one) .303 LMG magazine,
 - xi) 01 (one) SLR magazine,
 - xii) 03 (three) Tube launchers,
 - xiii) 03 (three) B.P. helmets, and
 - xiv) 01 (one) B.P. cover.
 2. On 29.06.2026, Manipur Police recovered from a forest area in Champanagar under Jiribam-PS, Jiribam district, inter alia, the following:
 - i) 06 (six) SLRs,
 - ii) 01 (one) AK Rifle,
 - iii) 05 (five) Magazines, and
 - iv) 625 (six hundred twenty five) live rounds ammunition of different calibers.
- III. On 29.06.2026, security forces intercepted a Tata Yodha (MN-06LA-3305) at T-Khullen Naka Check point under Senapati-PS, Senapati district and arrested its driver and occupant, both residents of Kangpokpi district along with contraband items:
 - i) Helkho Kipgen (45) of Keithelmanbi village, (driver) and
 - ii) Ms. Hatneihing Kipgen (40) of Hengbung Village.

From their possession, inter alia, the following were seized:

 - i) 42 soap cases of suspected Brown Sugar weighing approximately 530 grams,
 - ii) The intercepted Tata Yodha, and
 - iii) Rs. 5000/-(five thousand).
- IV. On 29.06.2026, the DGP, Manipur, Shri Mukesh Singh, IPS, along with ADGP (L&O) briefed the officers and commanders of the Special Commando Unit at PHQ. The briefing focused on operational preparedness, professionalism, discipline, and coordinated efforts to effectively address emerging security challenges in the State.
- V. Movement of **300** vehicles carrying essential items along NH-37 has been ensured. Strict security measures are taken up in all vulnerable locations and security convoy is provided in sensitive stretches in order to ensure free and safe movement of the vehicles.

- VI. A total of **117** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.
- VII. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- **9233522822** of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
