

**PRESS NOTE**  
**Imphal, the 3<sup>rd</sup> July, 2026**

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts:
- III. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
  1. On 01.07.2026, security forces arrested 02 (two) PLA cadres, both belonging to Thoubal district from the proximity of BP-86 under Tengnoupal-PS, Tengnoupal district:
    - i) Laishram Henry Singh (25) of Khangngabok Sorokwangma Part-1 and
    - ii) Soibam Quinton Singh (19) of Keirembikhok Mamang Leikai.
  2. On 03.07.2026, Manipur Police arrested one Ningthoujam Aknganba Meitei (27) of Awang Ngairangbam from his residence in Imphal East district for his involvement in looting the armory of MPTC, Pangei earlier in 2023, and firing at a residential site in Tangkham Awang Leikai, Imphal East district.
  3. On 03.07.2026, security forces arrested 02 (two) active cadres of RPF/PLA from their respective residences:
    - i) Ningthoujam Gulson Singh alias Bhupon (36) of Naharup Pangong Makhong, an extortionist active cadre of RPF/PLA and
    - ii) s/s Lieutenant Ng. Surjit Singh alias Kaka alias Koko (41) of Kakwa Ningom Thongjao, Imphal West district, (Finance Secretary of RPF/PLA, Imphal West).

Besides other articles, the following were recovered from the former:

    - i) 01 (one) .32 Pistol with magazine,
    - ii) 01 (one) 12 Bore DBBL Gun,
    - iii) 01 (one) SBBL Gun,
    - iv) 02 (two) rounds of 12 Bore cartridges and
    - v) 01 (one) STEYR M9-A1 Pistol along with a magazine loaded with six live rounds ammunition.
  4. On 03.07.2026, security forces arrested an active cadre of KCP (PWG), one Kangabam Deni Singh alias Bony (40) of Langathel Keithel Macha, Thoubal district from IVR Langathel Khongjom Road area under Khongjom-PS, Thoubal district.
- IV. On 02.07.2026, Manipur Police arrested 03 (three) residents of Churachandpur district from their respective residences under Churachandpur-PS, along with contraband and other incriminating items:
  - i) Zamngaihlian Tombing (48) of Zion Veng, New Lamka,
  - ii) Niangngaihching (43) of Pangzawl and
  - iii) Manglunsang Tawtak (36) of Pangzawl.

The following were seized from them:

- i) 186 soap cases of suspected Brown Sugar weighing approximately 2.5 kgs,
- ii) A sum of ₹ 31,43,500/- in cash,
- iii) A white Bolero (MN-06LX-5142) and
- iv) A cash-counting machine.

- V. Movement of **150** vehicles carrying essential items along NH-37 has been ensured. Strict security measures are taken up in all vulnerable locations and security convoy is provided in sensitive stretches to ensure free and safe movement of the vehicles.
- VI. A total of **113** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.
- VII. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- **9233522822** of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
