

PRESS NOTE
Imphal, the 30th June 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts resulting in recovery of arms and ammunition:
 1. On 29.06.2026, Manipur Police recovered from Sanjenlok area under Sagolmang-PS, Imphal East district, inter alia, the following:
 - i. 01 (one) AK rifle,
 - ii. 15 (fifteen) ammunition rounds of different calibers,
 - iii. 01 (one) 9mm Pistol,
 - iv. 01 (one) Country made Carbine,
 - v. 19 (nineteen) No. 36 hand grenades,
 - vi. 02 (two) Tube launchers (SLR),
 - vii. 07 (seven) .303 HD Cartridges,
 - viii. 06 (six) .303 blank rounds Cartridges,
 - ix. 10 (ten) Detonators,
 - x. 09 (nine) magazines of different arms.
- III. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
 1. On 30.06.2026, Manipur Police arrested from Khabeisoi area in Imphal East district an active cadre of KYKL involved in transportation of arms and ammunition, one Soraisam Joykumar alias Etomba (45) of Kachikhul Mayai Leikai, Imphal West district.
 2. On 30.06.2026, Manipur Police arrested an active cadre of RPF/PLA, one Elangbam Raju Singh (34) of Hiyanglam Mayai Leikai from his locality under Hiyanglam-PS, Kakching district.
 3. On 29.06.2026, following investigation into a FIR registered at Porompat-PS related to hurling of hand grenades at a Brahmapur residence in Imphal East district earlier, Manipur Police arrested 03 (three) active cadres of PREPAK involved in the case from Sawombung area under Lamlai-PS:
 - i. Sorokhaibam Rohit Meitei alias Salai (24),
 - ii. Salam Yaiphaba Meitei alias Khajing (20) and
 - iii. One Juvenile.

Investigation has established that out of a consignment of six grenades supplied to them by their handler, five have been hurled at different residential locations in Imphal East and Imphal West districts earlier. The remaining grenade and two scooters which they used for conveyance in committing the crimes have been recovered.
 4. On 29.06.2026, Manipur Police arrested two extortionists active cadres of KYKL, both residents of Wangoo Sabal from Kumbi area under Kumbi-PS, Bishnupur district:
 - i. Pukhrambam Bimol Meitei alias Inaobi (41), and
 - ii. Pukhrambam Rabi Singh alias Khang (37)

A Honda Activa 3G (MN01F-3127) was seized from them.

- IV. On 29.06.2026, security forces intercepted a I20 Hyundai car (GJ-27BL-0847) at Leingangpokpi under Jiribam-PS, Jiribam district and arrested its occupants (belonging to Rajasthan) along with contraband items:
- i) Dhanraj Prajapat (46), and
 - ii) Buddha Ram (44).
- Approximately 5 kgs of opium, cash worth Rs 50,000, and the intercepted vehicle were seized from the duo.
- V. On 29.06.2026, Manipur Police recovered two lost mobile phones which were reported missing earlier at Senapati-PS, Senapati district. The recovered phones have since been handed over to their rightful owners after due verification.
- VI. Movement of **330** vehicles carrying essential items along NH-37 has been ensured. Strict security measures are taken up in all vulnerable locations and security convoy is provided in sensitive stretches to ensure free and safe movement of the vehicles.
- VII. A total of **115** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.
- VIII. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- **9233522822** of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
