

PRESS NOTE
Imphal, the 4th July 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Upon receiving a complaint report from Titabar-PS, Assam about a person being unlawfully kept at Khamsom, Senapati district as collateral for matters related to financial transactions, Manipur Police traced and rescued two victims belonging to Assam from Changta village under Lungchon Maiphai-PS, Ukhrul district on 03.07.2026:
 - i) Kasob Kachari (29), and
 - ii) Ajay Gogoi (33).
- III. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts resulting in recovery of arms and ammunition:
 1. On 04.07.2026, Manipur Police recovered from the hill top of Salungpham Uyok Ching under Heirok-PS, Thoubal district, the following:
 - i. 02 (two) Beretta Pistols, each with a magazine,
 - ii. 02 (two).32 Pistols, each with a magazine,
 - iii. 02 (two) Single Barrels,
 - iv. 12 (twelve) grenades,
 - v. 07 (seven) magazines of different arms,
 - vi. 1242 (one thousand two hundred forty two) ammunition rounds of different calibers.
 2. On 04.07.2026, security forces recovered from Mombi Village general area under Molcham-PS, Chandel district, the following:
 - i. 09 (nine) Single Bore Rifles,
 - ii. 02 (two) 9mm Pistols, each with magazine,
 - iii. 02 (two) Improvised Mortars,
 - iv. 01 (one) Stick Hand Grenade, and
 - v. 94 (ninety four) ammunition rounds of different calibers.
- IV. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
 1. On 03.07.2026, Manipur Police arrested an extortionist active cadre of UNLF (P), one Chandam Geetchandra Singh (34) of Sanjenbam Mayai Leikai, Imphal East district, A/P Reliance Trend building, Paona Bazar from Mantripukhri area under Heingang-PS, Imphal East district.
 2. On 04.07.2026, Manipur Police arrested three extortionists active cadres of KCP (PWG) from different locations of Imphal East and Imphal West districts:
 - i. Ningombam Ajitkumar Singh alias Abung alias Khagemba (46) of Singjamei Makha Khongnang Pheidekpi, Imphal West district,
 - ii. Laishram Surjit Meitei alias Kadamba (43) of Wangkhei Tokpam Leikai, Imphal East district, and
 - iii. Laishram Birjit Singh alias Khuman (35) of Keishampat Thokchom Leikai, Imphal West District.

A Honda Activa scooter (MN-01AL-4757) and other miscellaneous items were recovered from them.

- V. Movement of **521** vehicles carrying essential items along NH-37 has been ensured. Strict security measures are taken up in all vulnerable locations and security convoy is provided in sensitive stretches to ensure free and safe movement of the vehicles.
- VI. A total of **115** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.
- VII. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- **9233522822** of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
