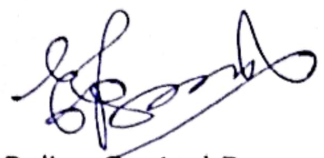


PRESS NOTE
Imphal, the 5th July 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts resulting in recovery of arms and ammunition:
 1. On 05.07.2026, security forces recovered from the hill range of Koubru near Mangjol Village under Gamnom Sapermeina-PS, Kangpokpi district, the following:
 - i. 01 (one) 5.56 mm INSAS Rifle with magazine,
 - ii. 24 (twenty four) SBBL Guns,
 - iii. 01 (one) DBBL Gun,
 - iv. 01 (one) country made pistol,
 - v. 02 (two) Pompis,
 - vi. 01 (one) Local made hand grenade,
 - vii. 35 (thirty five) ammunition rounds of different calibers and
 - viii. 02 (two) Walkie Talkie sets.
- III. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
 1. On 04.07.2026, security forces arrested 03 (three) extortionists active cadres of UNLF (Pambei) from Keikhu area under Porompat-PS, Imphal East district:
 - i) Elangbam Tomba Singh (44) of Bamon Kampu Awang Leikai, A/p Naharup Huiem Leikai,
 - ii) Patrick Golmei (44) of Keikhu Mayai Leikai,
 - iii) Athokpam Borish Singh (34) of Naharup Huiem Leikai.
 2. On 04.07.2026, security forces arrested an active cadre of KCP (MFL) one, Soram Manaoton Meitei alias Yening alias Udupa (32) of Moreh Heinoumakhong Ward No. 7, Tengnoupal district, a/p Zomi Villa, North AOC, Imphal from Andro area under Andro-PS, Imphal East district.
A two-wheeler scooter and a mobile phone were seized from him.
- IV. On 04.07.2026, security forces arrested 04 (four) persons from different locations under Lamlai-PS in Imphal East district in related incidents and seized approximately 239 kgs contraband ganja:
 - i) Mataime W. Shimray of Ukhrul district, arrested along with the Mahindra Bolero Pickup (MN-01AA-5728) he was driving,
 - ii) Ngangbam Dinesh (18),
 - iii) Phuritshabam Yaiphaba Meitei (18) arrested along with a TVS Apache RTR 160,
(They were arrested from Chingarel Tejpur).
 - i) Oinam Abung Meetei (42) of Pungdongbam Makha Leikai, arrested from his residence.
- V. Manipur Police continue its drive to curb motor vehicle offences:
 1. From 29.06.2026 to 05.07.2026, Manipur Police issued **76 (seventy six)** challans to motor vehicle offenders, amounting a total of **Rs. 1,62,500/- (one lakh sixty two thousand five hundred)**.



2. From 28.06.2026 to 04.07.2026, tinted films from **12 (twelve)** vehicles were removed.
- VI. A total of **114** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.
- VII. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number-9233522822 of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
