

PRESS NOTE
Imphal, the 6th July 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Two personnel of Assam Rifles were martyred today in an ambush by suspected militants on NH-202 near Nounghshong Kong village under Ukhrul-PS, Ukhrul district.
Security forces rushed in to the site of attack and there was exchange of fire. Further operations are underway to neutralise the militants.
- III. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts resulting in recovery of arms and ammunition:
 1. On 06.07.2026, during area domination and foot patrolling at Chiru village in Phayeng area under Kangchup-PS, Kangpokpi district, personnel of Manipur Police recovered a suspected IED, and four local made mortar shells.
- IV. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
 1. On 05.07.2026, security forces arrested an active cadre of URF, one Md. Imran Khan alias Carbine (29) of Khabeiso Sabal Leikai, Imphal East district from Khurai Nandeibam Leikai area under Porompat-PS, Imphal East district.
 2. On 05.07.2026, security forces arrested an extortionist active cadre of NRFM, one Sorokhaibam Pari Singh alias Ibungo (27) of Senjam Chirang Mayai Leikai, Imphal West district from Luwangsangbam Makha Leikai under Heingang-PS, Imphal East district.

The arrestee was involved in a recent firing incident earlier at a residential house at Pangei, Imphal East to intimidate and cause payment of extortion money.
 3. On 06.07.2026, security forces arrested two juvenile active cadres of KNF (MC) from the MVCP at P. Geljang, Churachandpur district along with 77 (seventy seven) 5.56 mm live rounds ammunition.
 4. On 06.07.2026, Manipur Police arrested an extortionist active cadre of UNLF (P), one Moirangthem Naoba Meitei (32) of Serou Mamang Leikai, Kakching district, a/p Wangkhei Yonglan Leirak, Imphal East from his current locality under Porompat-PS.
The following were recovered from him:
 - i) A Thompson repeater Single barrel and Gun license,
 - ii) 02 (two) Baofeng Hand Held sets along with 2 (two) chargers.
- V. On 05.07.2026, upon receiving a complaint of sexual assault on a minor girl at Women-PS, Senapati district, Manipur Police arrested the accused person, one K. Luckyson Pundi (33) of Maram Bazar under Maram-PS, Senapati district from his residence.
- VI. On 04.07.2026, Manipur Police Training College, Pangei in collaboration with the Manipur Forest Department celebrated "Van Mohotsav-2026" by planting 250 (two hundred and fifty) plant saplings inside the College campus.
Presided by the i/c Director of the College, Shri Sorokhaibam Gautam Singh, IPS, the function was attended by Shri Vikram Suresh Nadhe, IFS, DFO, Central Forest Division, Government of Manipur as the Chief Guest. Altogether, 180 (one hundred and eighty) enthusiastic personnel participated in the planting-cum-sensitisation programme.
The celebration of "Van Mohotsav" is a continuation of the efforts of Manipur Police Training College, Pangei towards building a greener and healthier planet.

- VII. Movement of **300** vehicles carrying essential items along NH-37 has been ensured. Strict security measures are taken up in all vulnerable locations and security convoy is provided in sensitive stretches to ensure free and safe movement of the vehicles.
- VIII. A total of **113** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.
- IX. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number-9233522822 of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
